

Notification – St Marys

St Marys Station footbridge

August 2023

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and pedestrian plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project.

Work will continue over the next four weeks on the construction of a site project office on Harris Street and site investigations in the area.

What work are we doing in August?

Work activities planned for Harris Street site project office:

- External civil and landscaping work
- Internal fit out
- Removing tower crane

Work activities planned for the St Marys Station footbridge:

- Utility investigations on station platforms within the rail corridor and in the vicinity of the multi-storey commuter car park
- Borehole drilling to test ground materials
- Survey work on the station platforms during off-peak hours with minimal disruption to customers
- Soil testing in South Creek Park
- Geotechnical testing of soils and compaction
- Set up of additional site sheds and work areas

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on station platforms, in the area between the rail corridor and the Harris Street multi-storey commuter car park and some parts of the car park. Two laydown areas within the rail corridor accessed from Hobart Street near Australia Street will be used to store construction materials and equipment. Please see maps on page 3 for work locations.

Standard work hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 7am to 1pm, Saturday.**

Weekend and night work

As the Harris Street site project office work is nearing completion, we will notify residents and businesses of any upcoming out-of-hours work to dismantle the tower crane. In late August, there may be deliveries of materials and equipment to the Harris Street site project office work area outside of standard construction hours to set up additional site sheds.



Weekend work three-month lookahead:

Activity	Timing
Piling, platform work, platform hoarding installation, material delivery and removal and utility investigations	1-4 September (Sydney Trains scheduled trackwork weekend)

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Noise and vibration from machinery and equipment including drill rigs, excavators, plate compactors, dump trucks, front end loaders, vacuum trucks, dump trucks, semi-trailers and rigid trucks, scissor and knuckle booms, mobile crane, power tools, survey equipment and hand tools.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This site compound is designed to minimise impact.

This includes:

- Fencing for safety and security
- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- Traffic control to help manage construction vehicles entering and leaving our site

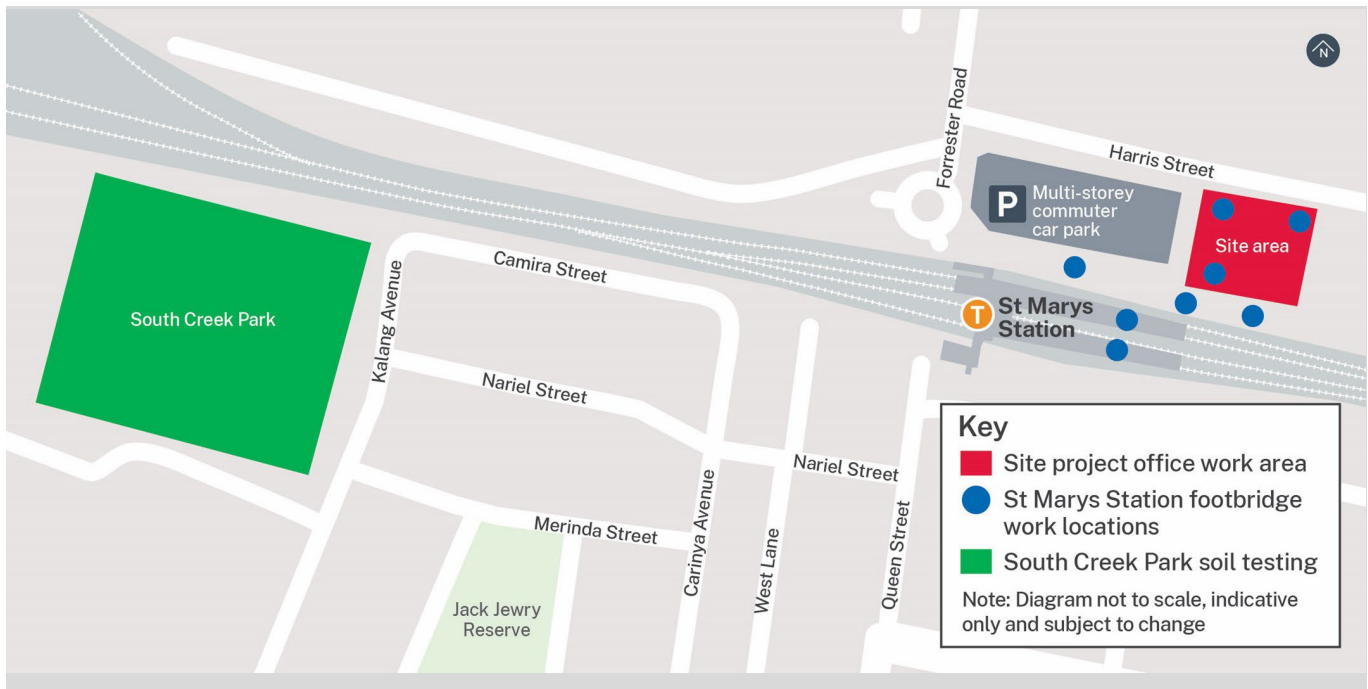


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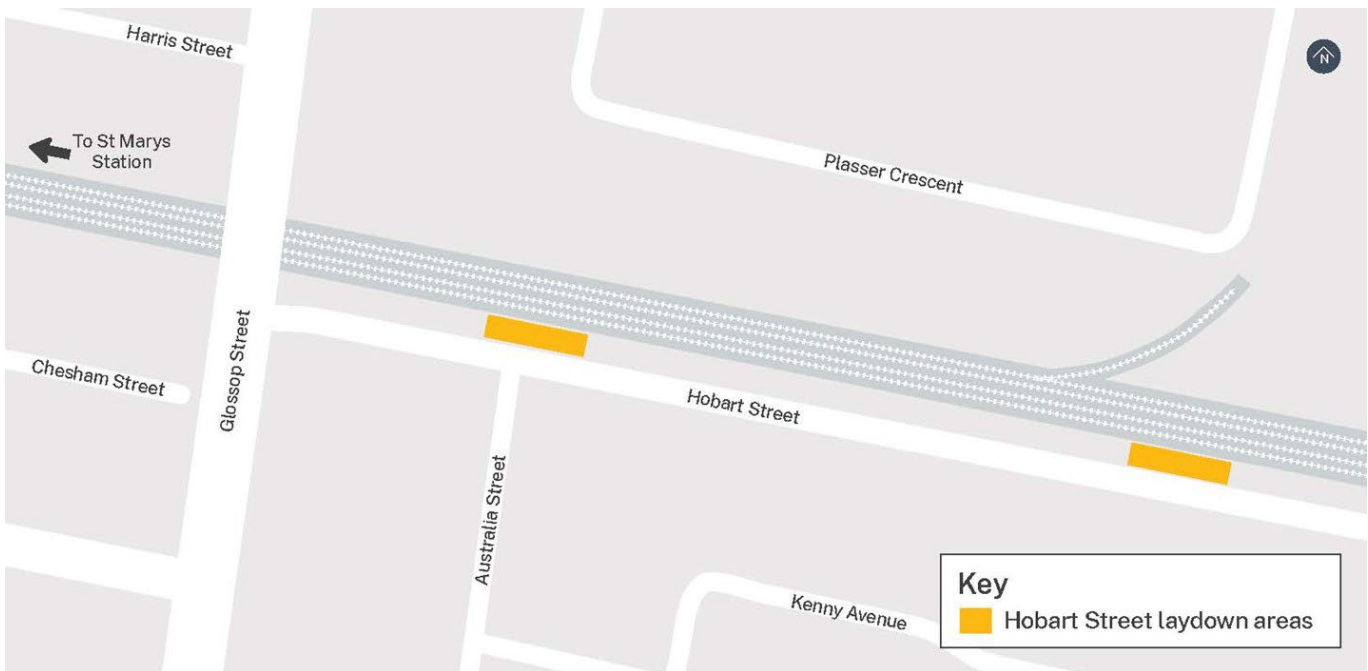
