



Notification – The Bays, Rozelle

3 July 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West. Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at The Bays.

John Holland CPB Contractors Ghella Joint Venture (JCG) has been awarded the contract to deliver 3.5 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Hunter Street and excavate the Pyrmont and Hunter Street metro stations. Both projects will establish separate construction sites at The Bays with joint activities covered in this monthly update.

Out-of-hours work update – Roberts Street, Rozelle

AFJV is carrying out utility inspections along Robert Street. This work must occur outside standard construction hours to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

Night work on Robert Street will occur between 8pm and 5am on Monday 10 July 2023.

Night work will Include:

- Set up traffic control
- Inspection of Sydney Water hydrants and valves at six (six) locations along Robert Street
- Painting and placing markers for utility fittings
- Pack up of traffic control


Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work Includes but Is not limited to: hand tools and light vehicles.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

Traffic control measures will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes to traffic conditions including partial road and footpath closures on Robert Street. A contraflow set up in place so two-way traffic can be maintained.
