Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres. Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock.

Out-of-hours work at Five Dock

AFJV is working with Sydney Water to upgrade water supply infrastructure in Five Dock. This work must occur outside standard construction hours due to road restrictions, to minimise impact on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

Installation and preparation of new Sydney Water supply connections in front of the western site in Great North Road will occur **between 6pm and 5am** on **Monday 4, Wednesday 6 and Thursday 7 September 2023.** The contingency dates are Wednesday 13 and Thursday 14 September 2023.

The work will include:

- Excavating trenches and installing additional pipes and joints
- Flushing, cleaning and CCTV inspection of water supply pipes
- Backfilling or covering trenches with steel plates between shifts where required
- Backfilling and sealing excavated areas upon completion of all the work

What to expect:

- There will be some noise associated with this work, but we will try to minimise this as much as possible. Any highly noisy work such as concrete cutting or hammering must be **completed before 12am (midnight).**
- Noise curtains will be used where practical to further mitigate noise from this work
- Three (3) parking spaces on Great North Road in front of St Albans church will be closed during this work
- There will be no impact on water supply to surrounding properties during this work.

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: excavator with hammer, vacuum truck, light vehicles, plate compactor, concrete truck, concrete saw, lighting towers, tool van, road plates, small generator, electric tools and hand tools.

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Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists during this work. A section of the north bound lane on Great North Road will be closed during this work with two-way traffic maintained under traffic control guidance. The footpath on Great North Road will remain open.
