Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West. Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at The Bays.

John Holland CPB Contractors Ghella Joint Venture (JCG) has been awarded the contract to deliver 3.5 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Hunter Street and excavate the Pymont and Hunter Street metro stations. Both projects have established separate construction sites at The Bays.

Concrete barrier installation and trenching work on Port Access Road

AFJV will be installing a pipe under Port Access Road to connect the spoil shed to the water treatment plant. A concrete barrier will also be installed along the eastern side of Port Access Road next to the spoil shed. This work will occur from **Thursday 19 October to Wednesday 1 November 2023** during standard construction hours **between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday (excluding Friday 27 October)**.

Work will include:

- Setting up traffic control
- Saw cutting asphalt
- Trenching and backfilling with excavated material
- Pipe installation
- Fixing steel formwork
- Installation of concrete barriers
- Pack up of traffic control

What to expect:

Traffic will be reduced to one lane along Port Access Road during work hours. Two-way access will be maintained and traffic control will be in place during this work.

Equipment used:

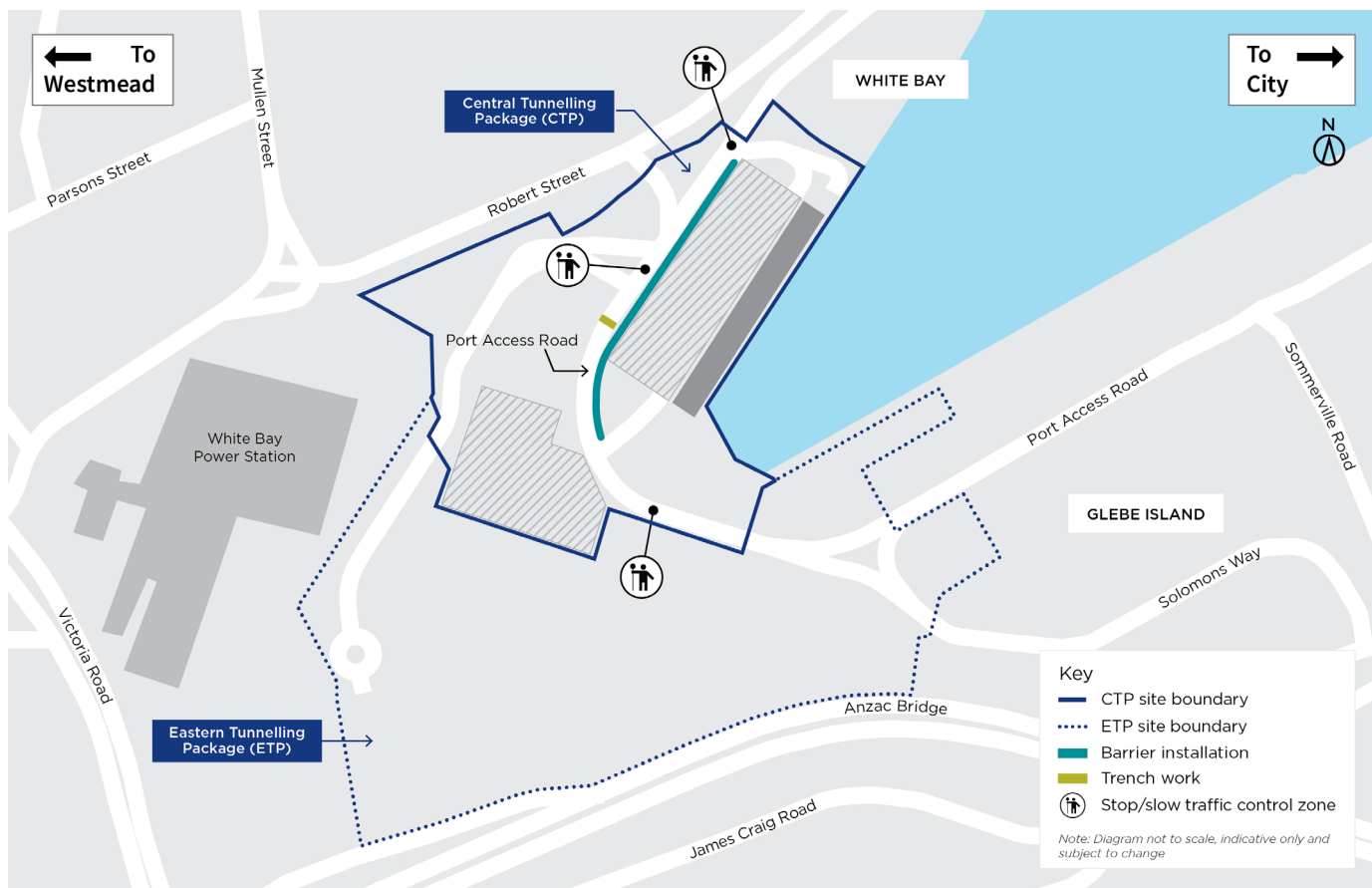
Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: an excavator, concrete saw, vacuum truck, hand tools, light vehicles, concrete agitator and concrete vibrator.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

Temporary lane closures will be in place on Port Access Road during work hours and two-way traffic will be maintained under traffic control (see map below).

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists. Internal traffic management measures will be in place for work within The Bays construction site.
