



Out-of-hours work notification – Barangaroo Station

October 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD in 2024, with new metro railway stations at Crows Nest, Victoria Cross, Barangaroo, Martin Place, Pitt Street and Waterloo and new metro platforms at Central, and then onto Bankstown in 2025.

BESIX Watpac is building the new Barangaroo Station, including delivering the station fit-out and associated landscaping and civil works, including the re-alignment of Hickson Road.

Systems Connect (an unincorporated joint venture between CPB Contractors and UGL Limited) is delivering line-wide work, which includes installing metro rail track, power systems, communications, and infrastructure to turn the excavated tunnels into a working railway between Chatswood and Sydenham.

Upcoming out-of-hours work (OOHW) – Setting up single-lane traffic arrangement and a traffic switch at the northern end of Hickson Road

On Friday 27 October and Sunday 29 October 2023, Hickson Road will be closed between Barton Street and Towns Place from 7pm to 5am the following day, to enable work to build the final road alignment.

Work to construct the permanent road alignment **under the Dalgety and Windmill Street bridges** has been progressing well, with the eastern verge works currently under construction. To enable construction of the western pedestrian footpath and road finishes, we will switch traffic from the current road alignment to a temporary road alignment to the east. The traffic switch will occur **from 7pm on Friday 27 October until 5am the following day. During this time, Hickson Road will be closed overnight between Barton Road and Towns Place to allow safety barriers, fencing, and line marking to be completed.**

Work to build the final Hickson Road alignment between High Steps and 25 Hickson Road is nearing completion, and we expect to open that section of the final alignment in late November. To complete this section of the road, **we will establish a single lane of traffic in this area for up to four weeks.** This change is necessary to finish the final road alignment in the locations where it crosses over the current road alignment. During the single-lane closure, traffic controllers will manage traffic flow during the day, and portable traffic lights will be in place outside of construction hours.

To set up the first establishment of the single-lane, **between 7pm on Sunday 29 October and 5am the following day, Hickson Road will be closed for one night between Barton Road and Towns Place to enable the installation of water-filled road barriers and portable traffic lights.**

Due to the location of the work and for the safety of the public and workers, it is not possible to undertake these works during standard construction hours when the road is open. Closing the road overnight has the least overall impact to road users.

Full details for both one-night road closures are provided in the table on page 2 and the maps on pages 3 and 4.

What to expect

- Traffic management for the road closure diversion, including for pedestrian access.
- Temporary lighting will be used to ensure a safe work site and will be directed away from properties.
- Equipment to be used will be a 5-14 tonne excavator with bucket, lighting tower, line marking truck and other light vehicles, including for traffic control, and battery-powered hand tools.
- Pedestrian access to the foreshore will be diverted via the steps south of 30 Hickson Road (via Jenkins Street, Gas Lane and Kent Street) and Barangaroo Reserve. Accessible routes will remain available via the lifts at Barangaroo Reserve and Napoleon Street (marked on the map on page 3).
- The work is expected to generate moderate noise as excavators remove the hoarding. All noisy work will cease at midnight on both nights, and noise monitoring will be in place.

Our mitigation measures

- All vehicles will be turned off when not in use.
- Communication will be limited to radios only when moving/unloading materials, with no use of horns or loud radios.
- Trucks will avoid reversing onto and in site, where feasible.
- Non-tonal reversing alarms will be fitted to plant and machinery.

Hickson Road closure and traffic detours during out-of-hours work

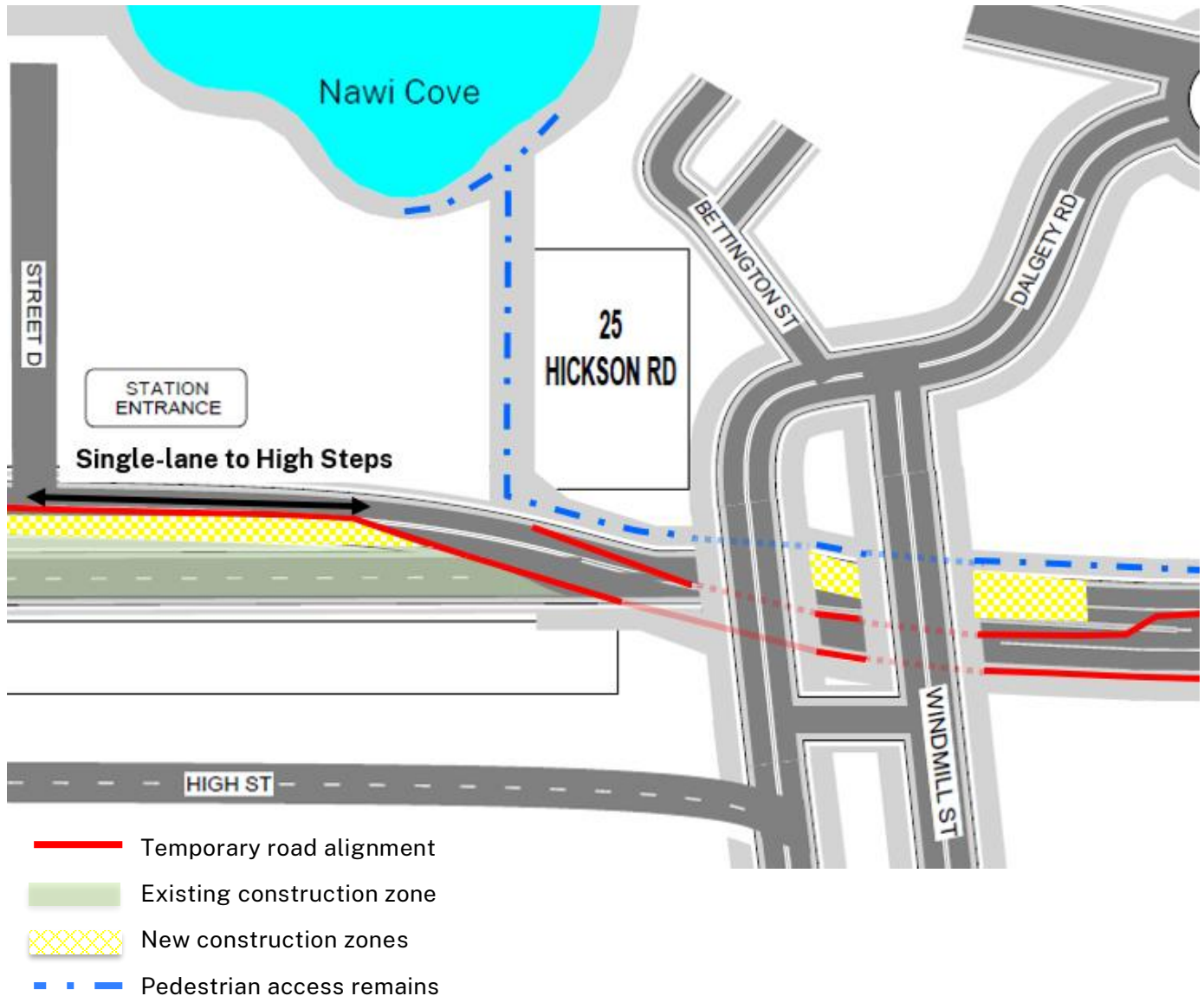
During these periods of work, Hickson Road will be closed between Towns Place and Barton Street between 7pm and 5am the following day. During this time, a detour will be in place via Towns Place, Dalgety Road, Kent Street and Napoleon Street. Bus services 311, 324 and 325 will be rerouted via this detour. There will be changes to bus stops, including the set-up of temporary bus stops near the corner of Kent Street and High Street. These temporary bus stops will service the 311, 324 and 325 bus services. For more information about temporary changes to bus routes 311, 324 and 325, please visit www.transportnsw.info/alerts#/bus.

Road users may experience short delays. Directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community. Please refer to the map below for road closure details, detour routes and temporary bus stops.
