Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024 with new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central. By 2030, Sydney will have four metro lines, with 46 stations and 113 kilometres of new metro rail.

Laing O'Rourke is delivering the new Sydney Metro platforms under Central Station as well as the landmark Central Walk - a new underground pedestrian concourse to help customers get around Sydney's busiest railway station.

Upcoming work in Randle Lane

From **Monday 16 October 2023**, for approximately four weeks, work will be undertaken to resurface the middle section of Randle Lane following damage from the recent nearby fire. A new kerb and communications pit will also be installed.

What to expect

- Excavation involving asphalt hammering will be required. High-impact noise and vibration activities are only permitted from 8am until 6pm Monday to Friday, and from 8am until 1pm on Saturdays. A one-hour respite period will be provided following three hours of noise-intensive work.
- Machinery and equipment used during this work includes excavators, tipper trucks, vacuum truck, construction vehicles, construction tools including hand and power tools, jack hammers and concrete saws.

Access to Randle Lane

- There will be no vehicle access to Randle Lane during these works and works being undertaken by Systems Connect, the contractor delivering Linewide works. Traffic management will be on site.
- Access to emergency exits onto Randle Lane will be maintained. There will be work near the 30-34 Chalmers Street emergency exit at times during the works however access will be maintained in coordination with the construction team. Access will be left clear at the end of every work shift.
- Waste collection will operate as usual.
- Other road users, cyclists and pedestrians should avoid Randle Lane and follow the directions of traffic controllers at all times.
