

# Monthly update – Westmead

25 October 2023

## Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Sydney Metro has engaged Quickway to relocate gas and telecommunications services around the future Westmead metro site.

## Construction activities: November 2023

Tunnelling contractor, GLC will continue major construction at the Westmead metro station site during November. These activities will be carried out during standard construction hours:

- **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 6pm**

Work will involve:

- Excavation of the station box using excavators, rock hammers and front-end loaders
- Installing rock bolts, ground anchors and spraying shotcrete where excavation occurs
- Installing, surveying, and monitoring of survey prisms within local streets and around the site
- Installing a water connection valve in a water pipe on Hawkesbury Road and Hassall Street
- Delivering and removing machinery, equipment, materials and spoil (excavated material).

## Out-of-hours work

To minimise interruption to local traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers around the site, some work must be undertaken outside standard construction hours.

Out-of-hours work will involve:

- Repairing a sewer pipe between Alexandra Avenue and Parramatta Park
- CCTV inspection of a sewer pipe on Park Avenue
- Installing, cleaning and maintaining survey devices within local streets and the rail corridor
- Delivering oversized machinery, material and equipment via Hassall Street and Hawkesbury Road.

Roadheader excavation is underway on the eastern and western sides of the station box, **24 hours a day, Monday to Sunday**. Concrete deliveries to support these activities will be via the Hawkesbury Road access gate between 10pm and 6am.

Quickway will commence site investigations from Thursday 26 October 2023. Site activities will be coordinated with GLC to minimise community impact as much as possible. A separate notification has been distributed about this work.

## Changes to traffic and pedestrian routes:

To facilitate access to work areas and safely operate machinery, there will be:

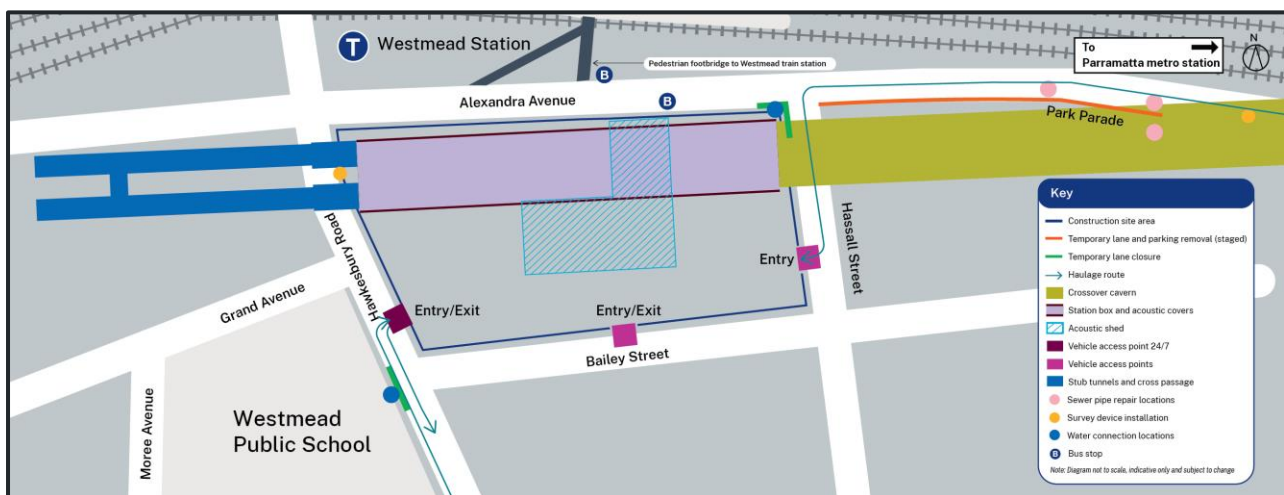
- Temporary lane closures in place on Hawkesbury Road, Hassall Street during day work and on Park Parade and Alexandra Avenue during night work
- Temporary removal of parking on Park Parade, Alexandra Avenue and Park Avenue during night work
- Temporary signage and traffic control to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with changes to traffic conditions
- Access to public transport will be maintained.

## What to expect:

- Noise blankets are used during night work where possible to minimise disturbance
- Lighting will be directed to the work areas and away from residential properties
- Noise, vibration and dust monitoring will be conducted
- Work on water and sewer assets is not expected to affect any residential services.

**Equipment used:** includes (but is not limited to) rock hammers, vacuum trucks, grinders, saws, excavators, concrete trucks and pumps, dozer, roadheaders, plate compactors, drilling rigs, spoil trucks, cranes, semi-trailers, loaders, dump trucks, tilt trays, tippers, generators, survey instruments, lighting towers, hand tools and light vehicles.
