# Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West — a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres. Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock.

### Out-of-hours work at Five Dock

AFJV is removing oversize equipment from the western site and upgrading water pipes near the site. This work must occur outside standard construction hours due to road restrictions, to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

Removal of oversize equipment will take place from 8pm to 5am on Thursday 9 and Friday 10 November 2023.

The equipment removal work will include:

- Delivery and set up of a large crane in the western site southern driveway
- Crane lift of equipment onto semi-trailers in Great North Road for transport offsite, with three loads on each night
- An excavator being tracked from the northern driveway onto a semi-trailer in Great North Road using rubber mats
- Pack up and removal of the crane

Preparation and connection of new Sydney Water supply pipes in front of the western site on the footpath and roadway of Great North Road will occur between 8pm and 5am on Monday 13, Tuesday 14, Thursday 16, Monday 20 and Thursday 23 November 2023. The contingency date is Tuesday 21 November 2023. Surface reinstatement of work areas will take place on Monday 27 and Tuesday 28 November 2023. The contingency dates are Thursday 30 November and Monday 4 December 2023.

The water supply pipe upgrade work will include:

- Flushing, cleaning, disinfection and testing of water supply pipes
- Excavation to prepare the connection points and switchover to the new water supply pipes
- Reinstatement of road and footpath surfaces following completion of the work

#### What to expect:

- There will be an overnight outage of the water supply to some surrounding properties on Thursday 23 November 2023 ONLY. Affected residents will be contacted directly by Sydney Water seven (7) to ten (10) days before the outage to confirm the times. If you do not get contacted you will not be affected.
- There will be noise associated with this work, but we will try to minimise this as much as possible.
- Clean water may be released into the gutter during pipe flushing with some collection by a vacuum truck
- Any highly noisy work such as concrete cutting or jack hammering must be completed by midnight

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
#### **Equipment used:**

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: semi-trailers, 400 tonne crane, excavator with hammer, vacuum trucks, concrete saws, plate compactors, concrete trucks, tipper trucks, light vehicles, lighting towers, tool vans, disinfection truck, small generator, electric tools and hand tools.

### Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

A section of the north bound lane on Great North Road will be closed during this work with two-way traffic maintained under traffic control guidance. The footpath on Great North Road will be closed in front of the western site during the work with a pedestrian detour in place. Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists during this work. Three (3) parking spaces on Great North Road in front of St Albans church will be closed during the night work.
