Project Update – Central Station

November 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown, with new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central. By 2030, Sydney will have a network of four metro lines, 46 stations, and 113km of new metro rail.

Laing O'Rourke is delivering the new Sydney Metro platforms under Central Station as well as the landmark Central Walk - a new underground pedestrian concourse to help customers get around Sydney's busiest railway station.

Reinstatement of Chalmers Street bike path and footpath

Out of hours work will be undertaken at night from **4pm to 10pm Wednesday 8 November** and **6pm Thursday 9 November to 4am Friday 10 November 2023** for the reinstatement of the bike path and footpath on Chalmers Street.

The work will involve cleaning the asphalt on the current shared path, painting and line-marking the path, and relocating fencing.

Cleaning the shared path will take place on the Wednesday 8 November shift and painting and line-marking will take place on the Thursday 9 November shift.

Equipment used for the work will include a vacuum truck, construction vehicles, a gas burner, hand tools and power tools.

A detour will be in place for pedestrians and cyclists from **4pm Wednesday 8 November to 4am Friday 10 November 2023.** Please see the map overleaf and follow the direction of signage and traffic controllers during the works.

All access to residential buildings and shops in the area will be maintained.

Randle Lane update

Work on Randle Lane is nearing completion, with the installation of a new kerb and asphalting the road underway.
