



# **Notification – Five Dock**

## Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West — a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres. Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock.

## Out-of-hours work at Five Dock

AFJV is upgrading water pipes and undertaking concreting work in and around the western site. This work must occur outside standard construction hours due to road restrictions, to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers. Due to heavy rain, the previously scheduled switchover to new water supply pipes could not be completed and the road surface had to be temporarily reinstated.

Preparation and connection of new Sydney Water supply pipes in front of the western site on the footpath and roadway of Great North Road will now occur **between 8pm and 5am** on **Monday 11 and Tuesday 12 December 2023**. Reinstatement of work areas will take place on **Thursday 14, Monday 18 and Tuesday 19 December 2023**. The contingency date is Thursday 21 December 2023.

The water supply pipe upgrade work will include:

- Flushing, cleaning, disinfecting and testing of water supply pipes
- Excavation to prepare the connection points and switchover to the new water supply pipes
- Reinstatement of road and footpath surfaces following completion of the work

A large concrete pour will be undertaken in the western site on **Tuesday 19 December 2023 from 4am** as an early start is needed to ensure completion in one continuous pour. This work is expected to be completed by 6pm however some low impact concrete surface finishing work such as sweeping and fanning may extend beyond 6pm.

## What to expect:

- There will be an overnight outage of the water supply to some surrounding properties on Tuesday 12 December 2023 ONLY. Affected residents will be contacted directly by Sydney Water seven (7) to ten (10) days before the outage to confirm the times. If you do not get contacted you will not be affected.
- There will be noise associated with this work, but we will try to minimise this as much as possible.
- Clean water may be released into the gutter during pipe flushing with some collection by a vacuum truck
- Any highly noisy work such as concrete cutting or jack hammering must be completed by midnight

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
#### Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: excavator with hammer, vacuum trucks, concrete saws, plate compactors, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, concrete vibrators, tipper trucks, light vehicles, lighting towers, tool vans, disinfection truck, jack hammers, small generator, electric tools and hand tools.

#### Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

A section of the northbound lane on Great North Road will be closed during work hours during the utility work with two-way traffic maintained under traffic control guidance. The footpath on Great North Road will be closed in front of the western site during the work with a pedestrian detour in place. Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists during this work. Six (6) parking spaces on Great North Road in front of St Albans church will need to be temporarily closed during each nightshift of this work.
