

Out-of-hours work notification – Barangaroo Station

January 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

Services started in May 2019 in the city's Northwest with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD in 2024, with new metro railway stations at Crows Nest, Victoria Cross, Barangaroo, Martin Place, Pitt Street and Waterloo, and new metro platforms at Central, and then onto Bankstown in 2025.

BESIX Watpac is building the new Barangaroo Station, including delivering the station fit-out and associated landscaping and civil works, including the re-alignment of Hickson Road.

Systems Connect (an unincorporated joint venture between CPB Contractors and UGL Limited) is delivering line-wide work which includes installing metro rail track, power systems, communications, and infrastructure to turn the excavated tunnels into a working railway between Chatswood and Sydenham.

Installation of gas infrastructure under Hickson Road (north)

Between Monday 15 January and Thursday 18 January 2024, BESIX Watpac will install gas infrastructure (for the existing local network) under the northern end of Hickson Road next to 25 Hickson Road. The work will occur between 7pm and 5am the following day.

Due to the location of the work and for the safety of the public and workers, it is not possible to undertake this work during standard construction hours as the work requires a full closure of Hickson Road and no pedestrian access between Nawi Cove and Towns Place via Hickson Road from 7pm to 5am the following day. On Monday 15 January, some of this work will be noisy, involving heavy plant and equipment such as excavators with rock breaking attachments, and a road saw. All noisy work will occur at the start of the shift and will cease at midnight.

The out-of-hours work will take place between 7pm and 5am the following day. The table (page 2) and map (page 3) provide full details of the dates and location of the work including traffic detours.

What to expect

- Traffic management to safely manage the closure of Hickson Road and the footpath between Nawi Cove and Towns Place (via Hickson Road).
- Temporary lighting to ensure a safe work site which will be directed away from properties.
- Equipment used will be an excavator with a hammer attachment (**noisy**) or bucket attachment, concrete saw (**noisy**) trucks (tipper, tool, vacuum, concrete), hand tools, drum roller, hand compactor, pipe welder and positrack bobcat.

- Pedestrian access to the foreshore will be diverted via High Steps, the public lift at the Cutaway and Barangaroo Reserve.
- Access to driveways along Hickson Road will be maintained for residents and businesses.
- Some of this work may be intermittently noisy. The project team will take every step possible to minimise noise impacts however there will be times when the work may be noisy, specifically when the excavator with hammer and road saw is in use.

Hickson Road and footpath closures with detours

During this period of out-of-hours work, **Hickson Road will be closed between Towns Place and Barton Street between 7pm and 5am the following day**.

During this time, a detour will be in place via Towns Place, Dalgety Road, Kent Street and Napoleon Street. Bus services 311, 324 and 325 will be rerouted via this detour. There will be some changes to bus stops, including temporary bus stops near the corner of Kent Street and High Street. These bus stops will service the 311, 324 and 325 bus services. **We respectfully ask residents to adhere to signage and ensure vehicles are not parked at the locations of the temporary bus stops during the detours.** For more information about temporary changes to the bus routes 311, 324 and 325, please visit https://transportnsw.info/alerts#/bus.

Road users may experience short delays. Directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community. Please refer to the map below for details of the road closure, detour routes and temporary bus stops.

There will be **no pedestrian access between Nawi Cove and Towns Place (via Hickson Road) between the hours of 7pm and 5am the following day**. Pedestrian detours will remain available via the High Steps, the public lift at the Cutaway and Barangaroo Reserve.

Directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community. Please refer to the map below for details about the pedestrian detours, including accessible detours.

Our mitigation measures

In addition to the respite hours during standard construction hours, the team will use the available methods to reduce noise impacts on the local community. Noise reduction techniques include:

- turning off equipment when not in use
- limiting the use of multiple pieces of loud machinery at the same time and location, where feasible
- temporary noise blankets installed on site, where feasible
- operating equipment on the lowest effective vibration setting, where feasible
- trucks avoiding reversing on and into site, where feasible
- using non-tonal reversing alarms on all equipment
- limiting communication to radios only when moving/unloading materials, with no use of horns or loud radios.
