



Monthly update - Parramatta

27 December 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Construction activities: January 2024

Tunnelling contractor, GLC will continue major construction at the Parramatta metro station site during January. These activities will be carried out during standard construction hours:

Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 6pm

Work will involve:

- Removing concrete sections and piles in stages with saw cutters and jackhammers.
- Delivering and removing machinery, equipment, and materials via George Street.
- Testing and commissioning of the water treatment plant.
- Constructing a diaphragm wall and support work including piling.
- Excavating the station box including support work and concreting.
- Surveying, utility investigations and upgrades within and around site including United Lane.
- Aerial drone filming on-site. This will be in line with Civil Aviation Safety Authority guidelines.

Out-of-hours work

To minimise interruption to local traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers around the site, some work must be undertaken outside standard construction hours.

Out-of-hours work will involve:

- Construction of the diaphragm wall and support work will continue **24 hours a day, Monday to Sunday** until late May 2024.
- Excavation of the station box 24 hours a day, Monday to Sunday until late 2025.
- Spoil removal (excavated material), oversized machinery and equipment deliveries to the site between 6pm and 7am from Monday 8 January to Wednesday 31 January 2024.
- Surveying, utility investigations and upgrades within and around site between 6pm and 7am
 Monday to Friday from Monday 8 January to Wednesday 31 January 2024.

We will continue to keep you informed of our progress and planned out-of-hours work. To know more, register your details to receive weekly email updates by emailing metrotunnelsGLC@transport.nsw.gov.au.

Out-of-hours activities are in line with Road Occupancy Licences; and Transport for NSW requirements to work in the road corridor and for the movement of oversized vehicles.



What to expect

- Some activities will generate noise and vibration, but this will be minimised as much as possible.
- Access to businesses will be maintained unless arrangements are made with you in advance.
- Temporary signage and traffic control to assist motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists with changes to traffic conditions. Allow some extra time for your journey when travelling near these areas.

Equipment used: Equipment for this work will include but is not limited to hand tools, cranes, generators, truck and dogs, survey equipment, light vehicles, drill rigs, excavators, dozers, vibratory rollers and compactors, concrete agitators, vacuum excavation trucks, tipper trucks, delivery vehicles, fencing, road saw and traffic control devices.
