Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock.

Out-of-hours work at Five Dock

AFJV is undertaking closed circuit television (CCTV) inspections of stormwater and sewer lines around the construction sites in Five Dock. This work must occur outside standard construction hours due to road restrictions, to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

Water jetting and inspection of pipes will take place in Great North Road, East Street, Second Avenue and Waterview Street between 6pm and 5am on Wednesday 17 and Thursday 18 January 2024.

The inspection work will include:

- Water jetting pipes to clear them where required.
- Feeding CCTV camera line into pipes to record condition

What to expect:

- There will be noise associated with the water jetting, but we will try to minimise this as much as possible.
- The work is expected to take up to 3 hours at each location
- Residential access will be maintained

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes at each location.

- A section of the northbound lane on Great North Road will be closed for up to three (3) hours during work near Fred Kelly place with two-way traffic maintained under traffic control guidance
- Waterview Street and Second Avenue will remain open to vehicles with traffic control guidance
- Access to residential properties will be maintained during the work
- Up to four (4) street parking spaces will be occupied before and during work in Waterview Street and Second Avenue to ensure safe traffic flow and clear access

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: water jetting truck, CCTV vehicle, CCTV camera line, extension hose trailer, traffic control signage, hand tools.
