



Notification - Cross passage excavation

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West. Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations.

Cross passage excavation: Rodd Point

Cross passages are connection tunnels between the two main metro tunnels and are located about every 240 metres along the tunnel alignment. They are an important safety feature and allow people to move from one tunnel to another in case of an emergency. The cross passage in your area will be approximately 31 metres below ground and will be 5.5 metres wide, 6 metres high and 9 metres long (see map overleaf).

Construction of the cross passage near your property will start on 14 February 2024 and is expected to continue for up to four weeks, depending on ground conditions. Work will be carried out **24 hours a day, seven days a week.**

Work will Include:


- Excavating the cross passage using a rock hammer
- Installing grout to support the tunnel, drilling and saw cutting
- Safely removing excavated material via conveyor belts through the tunnels back to The Bays Station site and then transporting it by truck to be reused on other projects around Sydney
- Installing a waterproof concrete lining in the cross passage and surrounding area

What to expect:

- Some vibration and ground borne noise may be experienced as we work beneath or near your property
- The noise is less noticeable during the day when traffic, household or office noise levels are higher
- Noise and vibration modelling and monitoring will be undertaken for cross passage excavation.

Property condition surveys for eligible properties:

All properties within 15 metres of the outer edge of the tunnel alignment have already been offered a free property condition survey.

If you have not been contacted, your property is not eligible for a survey as part of this project.
