Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock.

Out-of-hours work at Five Dock

The tunnelling contractor, AFJV, is undertaking **road repair work in Second Avenue and Great North Road**. This work must occur outside standard construction hours due to road restrictions, to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

Out-of-hours work to replace some asphalt will be carried out **between 6pm and 5am on Monday 19 February 2024** in **Second Avenue and Great North Road** (weather and site conditions permitting). The contingency night is Tuesday 20 February 2024.

The work will include:

- Removing the current road surface with a road profiler machine
- Stabilising the road base and laying a new asphalt surface

What to expect:

- There will be noise associated with this work but we will try to minimise this as much as possible.
- Any highly noisy work such as saw cutting or jack hammering must be completed before midnight (12.00am)
- Traffic control staff will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes at each location


Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

- A section of Second Avenue will be closed to traffic during this work with access for residents via Great North Road
- A detour will be in place via Waterview Street to Barnstaple Road and Rodd Road under traffic control guidance
- A section of the southbound lane on Great North Road will be closed from 10pm to 5am during work near the Second Avenue intersection with two-way traffic maintained under traffic control guidance (see map overleaf).
- A pedestrian detour will be in place during the work on Great North Road at the Second Avenue intersection
- On street parking spaces in Second Avenue will be closed prior to and during the work to ensure clear access

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: road profiler, paving machine, roller, concrete saw, jack hammers, plate compactors, bobcat, bitumen spray truck, street sweeper, light vehicles, power tools, traffic control signage, hand tools.
