

Project update – Victoria Cross

February 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD in 2024, with new metro railway stations at Crows Nest, Victoria Cross, Barangaroo, Martin Place, Gadigal and Waterloo, and new metro platforms at Central, and then onto Bankstown in 2025.

Lendlease will deliver the new Sydney Metro Victoria Cross integrated station development at North Sydney, including the metro station, over station development (OSD) and enhancements to pedestrian connections, retail and public spaces.

What work are we doing?

Upcoming out-of-hours work – Victoria Cross

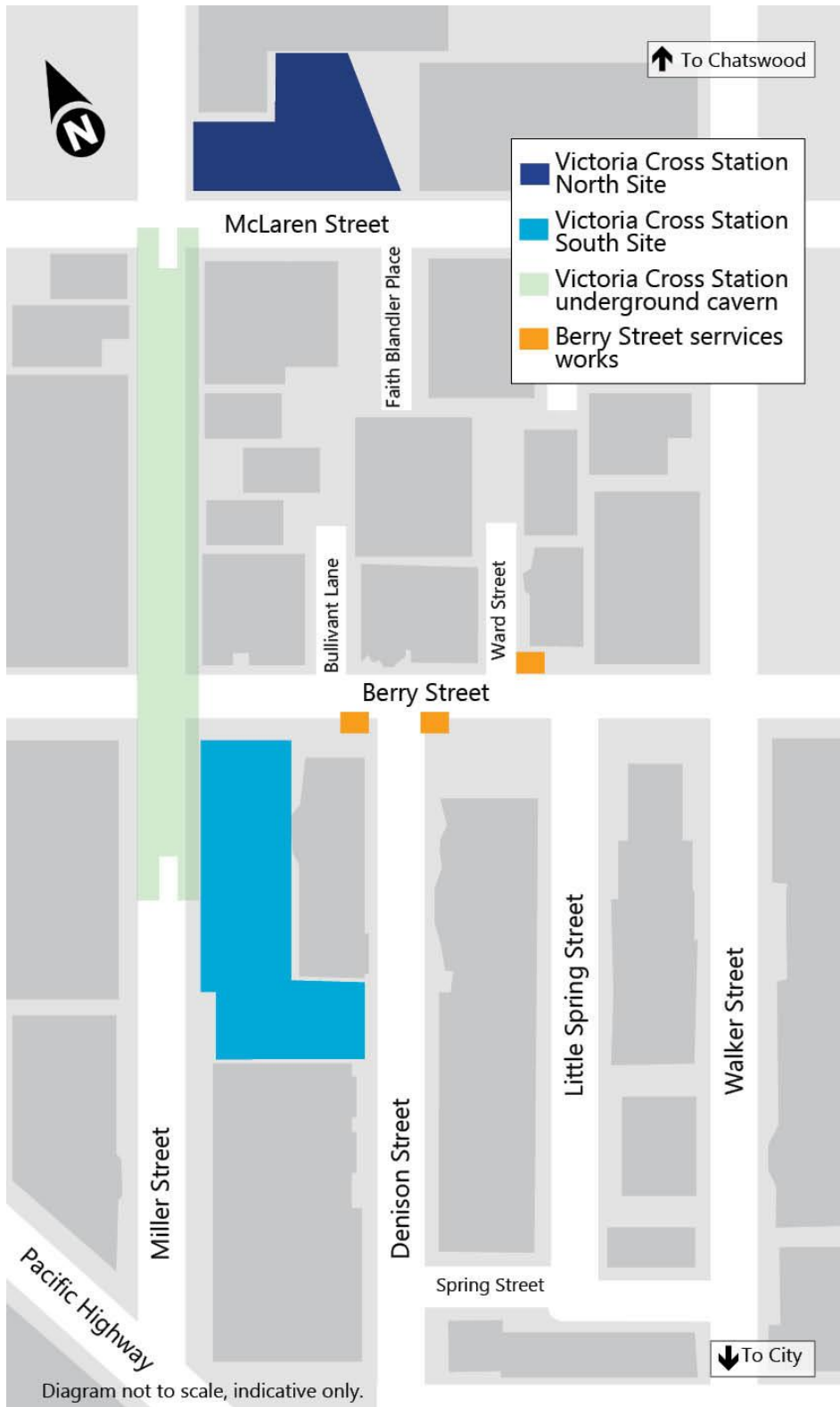
The table below is an indicative schedule of out-of-hours work on Berry Street. These works are in addition to those previously notified.

Dates and times	Location(s)	Work
Four nights between Monday to Friday, 19 February to 2 March, 8pm to 5am	Berry Street	Works will take place on Berry Street, at the Denison Street intersection and at the Ward Street intersection. Works include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Establishing the work zonessaw cutting and excavation via vacuum truckdeliveriestruck and small machinery movements.
Four nights between Monday to Friday, 26 February to 8 March, 8pm to 5am	Berry Street	Works will take place on Berry Street, at the Denison Street intersection and at the Ward Street intersection. Works include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">installation of electrical conduit using a small excavator.

What to expect

- Traffic, street parking and pedestrian changes to surrounding streets. Access to buildings and driveways will always be maintained.
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers, pedestrians and the community.
- Some of these activities will be noisy. Saw cutting and rock breaking will stop at 10pm. The project team will limit these impacts where possible. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used. Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
