

Project update – Victoria Cross

March 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD in 2024, with new metro railway stations at Crows Nest, Victoria Cross, Barangaroo, Martin Place, Gadigal and Waterloo, and new metro platforms at Central, and then onto Bankstown in 2025.

Lendlease will deliver the new Sydney Metro Victoria Cross integrated station development at North Sydney, including the metro station, over station development (OSD) and enhancements to pedestrian connections, retail and public spaces.

What work are we doing?

Upcoming out-of-hours work – Victoria Cross

The table below is an indicative schedule of out-of-hours works that will take place in and around the Victoria Cross south construction site. These works are in addition to those previously notified.

Friday 22 March 8pm to Monday 25 March 5am *contingency dates: 11pm Friday 5 April to 6am Monday 8 April	South site, via Denison Street.	Removal of tower crane, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• closure of Denison Street to through traffic - local access will be maintained for residents.• removal of crane structure from site• use of mobile cranes, lighting towers and hand-held tools.

What to expect


- Traffic and pedestrian changes to surrounding streets. Miller and Denison streets will be open to local traffic only. Access to buildings and driveways will always be maintained.
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers, pedestrians and the community.
- Some of these activities will be noisy. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used. Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
