Out-of-Hours Work – Luddenham South

April 2024 to July 2024

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A cityshaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

CPB Contractors and United Infrastructure Joint Venture (CPBUI JV) are completing the surface and civil alignment works contract for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport.

Change to timing for out-of-hours work:

The CPBUI JV project team is proposing to carry out work outside of our current standard construction hours (Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm). The current conditions allow the project to work up to three nights a week.

We are seeking your agreement to carry out work between **6pm Wednesday 1 May 2024** through to **5am Saturday 29 June 2024** (weather depending). Work will also take place during our standard construction hours **Monday** to **Friday**, **7am** to **6pm** and **Saturday**, **8am** to **1pm**. We will not work Saturday and Sunday nights or Public Holidays.

Changes we are proposing:

As part of Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport construction, earthworks for the surface alignment is required. During **May** to **June 2024**, civil earthworks at Luddenham South will be undertaken at night. During this time, there will be operation of heavy machinery, from **Monday** to **Friday**.

Noise monitoring and on-the-spot checks will be carried out to ensure compliance from the construction team and minimise impacts to stakeholders.

Why is out of hours work needed?

To ensure we deliver the work safely and on time we are proposing to schedule work across our project at different times and locations.

The proposed weekly duration of construction work is a *maximum time period* and is determined by the project requirements.
