



# **Notification – Five Dock**

## 7 May 2024

### Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail

capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock.

### Out-of-hours work at Five Dock

AFJV is undertaking closed circuit television (CCTV) inspections of sewer lines in Great North Road. This work must occur outside standard construction hours due to road restrictions, to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, workers and local businesses.

These inspections will be carried out **between 11pm and 5am on Tuesday 14 May 2024** in the southbound bus lane on **Great North Road** near Fred Kelly Place (weather and site conditions permitting). The contingency night is Wednesday 15 May 2024.

#### The work will include:

- Parking a vacuum truck in the bus lane at the work location
- Extending a cleaning hose to the manhole access point located behind the Five Dock Post Office
- Opening the manhole and inserting a robot to remove sewer pipe debris
- Water jetting the pipes to clear them, where required; and
- Feeding a CCTV camera line into the sewer pipes to record the condition

#### What to expect:

- There will be noise associated with this work, but we will try to minimise this as much as possible.
- The work is expected to take up to 4 hours.

#### Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

- Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes at the work location
- A section of the southbound bus lane on Great North Road will be temporarily closed near Fred Kelly Place under the guidance of traffic control
- Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times



- Access to residential properties will be maintained during the work
- A temporary pedestrian detour will be in place on Great North Road (see map overleaf).

#### **Equipment used:**

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: vacuum truck, light vehicles, water jetting hose, portable generator, CCTV cameras, a cleaning robot, compressor, traffic control signage and hand tools.
