

Project update – Barangaroo Station

October 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. On 19 August 2024, services began on the new section of the M1 Line, including 15.5 kilometres of metro rail extending from the existing Metro North West at Chatswood, under the harbour and through the Sydney CBD and onto Sydenham. Commuters can now catch metro services every four minutes in the peak from new stations at Crows Nest, Victoria Cross, Barangaroo, Martin Place, Gadigal and Waterloo, and new metro platforms at Central.

While all city stations are now open, commuters will notice hoarding and minor ongoing work in the precinct areas at most new stations. This work largely involves improvements to roads, footpaths and traffic intersections.

BESIX Watpac is building Barangaroo Station, including the station fit-out, associated landscaping and civil works, and the realignment of Hickson Road.

Barangaroo Station – upcoming work for October

Hickson Road will be closed between Barton Street and Towns Place on two nights in late September between 7pm and 5am the following day.

- 1. On the nights of Sunday 29 and Monday 30 September with Tuesday 1 October as contingency.** The closure will allow line marking work.

Specific details have been provided via notification which is also available on the Sydney Metro website.

Work to build the facades of the ventilation pods along the eastern side of Hickson Road will continue, including installing metal cladding. Construction of the kerb and pavement for the new bicycle path will continue, as will rendering on the heritage wall under High Street.

No pedestrian access along the heritage wall below High Street during the remaining construction

Pedestrian access on Hickson Road along the heritage wall will remain closed until Q4 2024, while the construction of the ventilation pods, footpath and cycle lane on the eastern side of Hickson Road is completed. Alternative access is now available on the new footpath on the western side of Hickson Road.

Location **Activities during standard construction hours**

<p>Hickson Road (between Windmill Street Bridge and High Steps)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Line marking the 25 Hickson Road car park (if not completed in late September) • Continue the rendering of the heritage wall under High Street, where required, using a mobile plant and /or from the scaffold. This work is being undertaken per heritage guidelines and will not generate noise. • Continuing the metalwork installation on the façade around the ventilation pods along the heritage wall under High Street. • Installing pavers around the ventilation pods and the footpath between 25 Hickson Road and High Steps on the eastern side. • Landscaping work around the ventilation pods including planting of trees and shrubs. • Demobilising the construction zone on the eastern side of Hickson Road under High Street. This includes removing the temporary fencing once the area is handed over to the City of Sydney. • Environmental monitoring from boats in the harbour, including using drones.
