

Monthly update – Five Dock

November 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Acciona Ferroviaria Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations including a station at Five Dock.

Work during November

With major excavation work completed, the main activities at the Five Dock Station sites throughout November will be the start of site demobilisation at the eastern construction site and ongoing cavern lining works, including delivery and assembly of the steel formwork and concrete pours.

Work planned for November includes:

- Construction of shaft and cavern concrete structures
- Tunnelling support activities including cross passage and central cavern construction
- Demobilising activities at the eastern construction site including scaffolding installation and dismantling the shed
- Decommissioning the water treatment plant
- Increased deliveries of equipment to and from the western construction site using both sides of Great North Road
Delivery and removal of material and equipment (out-of-hours deliveries and removals will be notified separately).

Work hours:

Unless otherwise stated, this work will be carried out during standard construction hours:

- **Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm and Saturday 8am – 6pm**

Work outside standard construction hours:

Some work must be undertaken outside standard construction hours to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers.

Out-of-hours work planned for November includes:

- Sydney Water inspections of redundant sewer lines in manholes on Second Avenue and East Street on **Wednesday 6 November 2024 between 8pm and 5am.**
- Finalising the permanent pavement works on Great North Road in the southbound bus lane every **Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday night from 12 November 2024 to 22 November 2024. Work hours between 6pm and 5am**, see map overleaf. A separate notification about this work was issued in September.
- Line marking on Great North Road from Fred Kelly Place to St Alban's Church and in the southbound bus lane in front of Australia Post on **Tuesday 26 November 2024 between 8pm and 5am.**
- A mobile crane delivery to and from the site to assist with formwork assembly every week **from 12 November 2024 to 29 November 2024.** This will be notified separately.

Activities associated with tunnelling support, such as concrete pours, cross passage construction, defect repairs, removal of temporary infrastructure and installation of underline service crossings inside the tunnel are **approved for 24-hour operation**. This includes tunnelling support activities inside the eastern acoustic shed as well as tunnelling support activities inside the excavated underground cavern and the excavated shaft on the western site (under strict noise criteria). No work is planned on the surface of the western site after 6pm unless otherwise notified.

Equipment used

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: trucks, light vehicles, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, road profilers, asphalt pavers, vibratory rollers, bobcat, compaction plate, road concrete saws, jackhammers, elevated work platforms, excavators, street sweepers, vacuum trucks, cranes, light towers, line marking machine, generators and power tools.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow lanes, stop-slow traffic controls to assist with truck movements, oversized deliveries and temporary lane or footpath closures.
