Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferroviaria Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock.

Out-of-hours work at Five Dock

AFJV is inspecting and rendering redundant Sydney Water sewer lines in manholes on Second Avenue and East Street. Sydney Water requires this work to be undertaken outside standard construction hours when the sewer systems flow is low.

These inspections will be carried out between **8pm and 5am on Wednesday 6 November 2024** starting on Second Avenue and moving to East Street (weather and site conditions permitting). The contingency night will be **Friday 8 November 2024**.

The work will include:

- Parking a tipper truck at the work location
- Opening the manhole and clearing any debris
- Feeding a CCTV camera line into the sewer pipes to record the condition; and
- Internal rendering works using light hand tools

What to expect:

- There will be noise associated with this work, but we will try to minimise this as much as possible.
- The work is expected to take up to 6 hours.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

- Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes at the work location
- Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times
- Access to residential properties will be maintained during the work (see map overleaf).

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: vacuum truck, light vehicles, small tipper truck, portable generator, CCTV cameras, traffic control signage and hand tools.
