

Monthly update – Westmead

22 December 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, transforming Sydney for generations to come.

This once-in-a-century infrastructure investment will provide fast, reliable turn-up-and-go metro services with fully accessible stations, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD. Two potential station locations are being investigated west of Sydney Olympic Park, including one at Rosehill Gardens which could support a significant increase in housing.

Construction activities on site: January 2025

Tunnelling contractor, GLC will continue major construction at the Westmead metro station site during January.

What work we are doing?

- Installing waterproofing membranes, formwork, steel fixing for the station box and caverns.
- Surveying, installing and monitoring of survey prisms within local streets and around site.
- Delivering and removing pre-fabricated steel cages, oversized machinery, material and equipment via Hassall Street and Hawkesbury Road.
- Concrete deliveries will be via the Hawkesbury Road access gate between 10pm and 7am.
- Jet cleaning and CCTV investigations of sewer pipes in Alexandra Avenue, Park Parade and Park Avenue between 4pm and 5am, Monday to Thursday from Monday 13 January to Thursday 23 January 2025.

Work will be conducted during standard working hours, **7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am – 6pm, Saturdays.**

Tunnelling and support activities will be 24 hours, six days a week.

Out-of-hours work and deliveries will also be required. Work activities are subject to ground and weather conditions and may be rescheduled if required. We will notify you via our email updates when this needs to happen.

Hawkesbury Road and Priddle Street intersection improvements:

GLC will adjust the pedestrian crossings at the intersection of Hawkesbury Road and Priddle Street, **during early 2025 from Monday 13 January.**

Work during standard construction hours will involve:

- Setting up traffic control and any temporary lane and footpath closures.
- Installing new fencing along the footpath on Hawkesbury Road.
- Excavating existing pram ramps and constructing wider ramps.
- Concrete cutting and sawing within the footpath and road corridor to widen the pram ramps and install traffic loops.
- Relocating two traffic signals.
- Delivering and removing machinery, equipment, concrete and materials.

Out-of-hours work

- Installing new traffic loops within the road corridor.
- Milling and resheeting of road surfaces and linemarking.

We will notify residents affected by out-of-hours activities once dates have been confirmed.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes include:

To facilitate access to these work areas and safely operate machinery, there will be:

- Intermittent lane and footpath closures in localised areas on Hawkesbury Road and Priddle Street. Access around work areas will be maintained by traffic control.
- Temporary signage and traffic control to assist pedestrians, motorists and cyclists with changes to road and footpath conditions.
- Traffic control will be in place to provide pedestrian access around the work activities.
- Access to public transport will be maintained.

What to expect:

- Noise blankets are used during night work where possible to minimise disturbance.
- Lighting will be directed to the work areas and away from residential properties.
- Noise, vibration and dust monitoring will be conducted.

Equipment used:

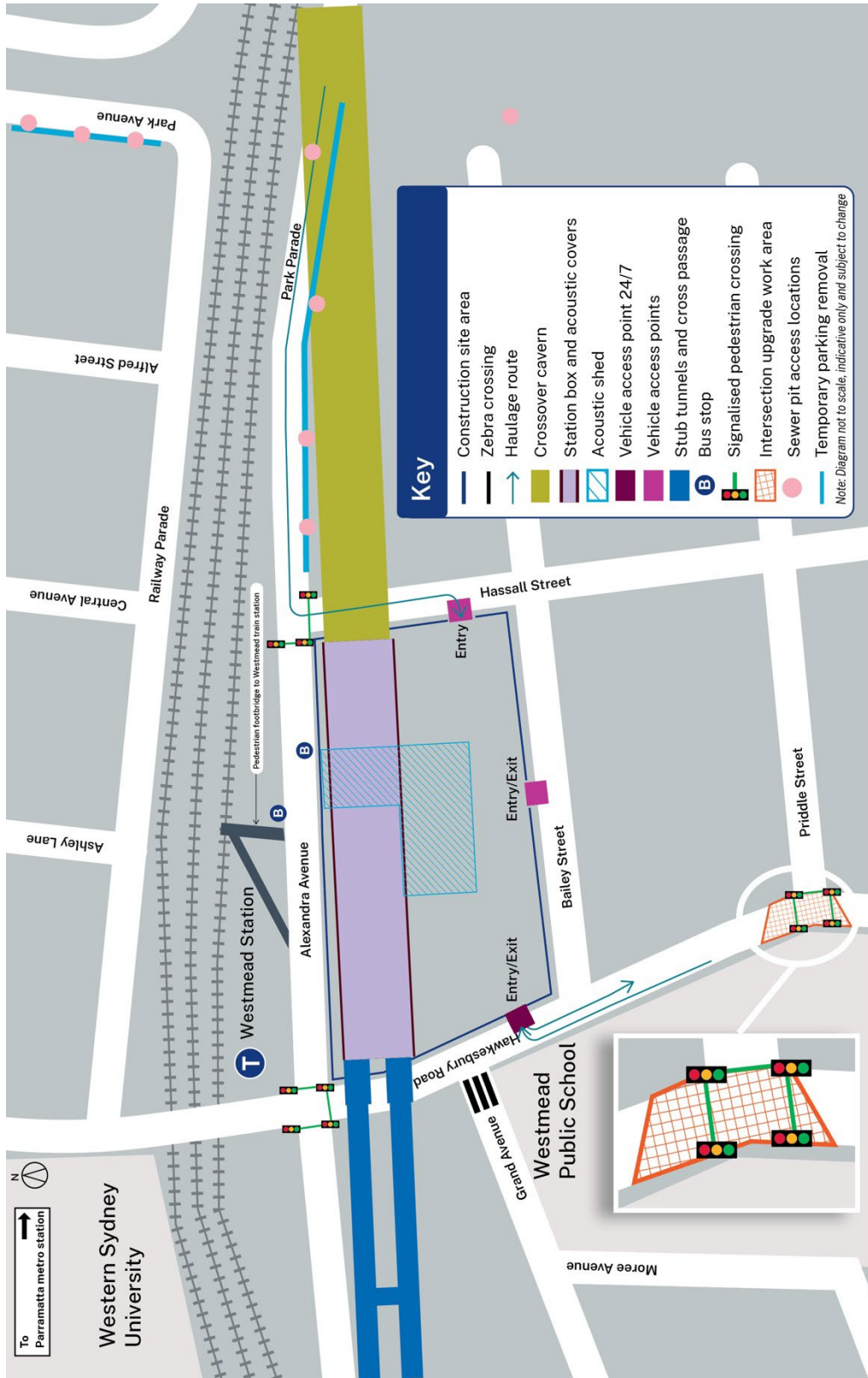
Includes (but is not limited to) jack hammers, concrete saw, vacuum trucks, grinders, excavators, concrete trucks and pumps, compressors, plate compactors, road profiler, asphalt paver, dump trucks, cranes, semi-trailers, lighting towers, water jet truck, CCTV equipment hand tools and light vehicles.
