

Permanent traffic conditions – Clyde

31 January 2025

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, transforming Sydney for generations to come.

This once-in-a-century infrastructure investment will provide fast, reliable turn-up-and-go metro services with fully accessible stations, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD. Two potential station locations are being investigated west of Sydney Olympic Park, including one at Rosehill Gardens which could support a significant increase in housing.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Permanent traffic and pedestrian conditions on new Unwin Street - Friday 7 February 2025

Traffic and pedestrians will be diverted to the newly constructed Unwin Street alignment and overbridge from **5 am on Friday, 7 February 2025. Depending on site progress and weather conditions, the new road and pathway may open earlier. We will keep you updated through our weekly email updates.** The old road and pathway will no longer be accessible to the public and will become part of the Sydney Metro site.

REMINDER: Temporary road closures to finalise construction of new Unwin Street – February 2025

- **8pm Saturday 1 February to 5am Monday 3 February 2025 – weekend road closure**
- **10pm Monday 3 February to 5am Tuesday 4 February 2025**
- **10pm Wednesday 5 February to 5am Thursday 6 February 2025**
- **10pm Thursday 6 February to 5am Friday 7 February 2025**

Road closures will be between the intersection of Wentworth and Martha Street and the intersection of Shirley and Unwin Street.

What to expect

- Access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian pathway will be available on the western side of the new Unwin Street alignment.
- Temporary signage and traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with changes to traffic conditions. Please keep to speed limits and follow the detours.
- Allow some extra time for your journey when travelling near these areas.
