

Monthly update – Five Dock

May 2025

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Acciona Ferroviaria Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations including a station at Five Dock.

Work during May

The main activities at the Five Dock Station sites throughout May will be site demobilisation at the eastern and western construction sites, installation of final hoarding, footpath repairs and road signage modifications.

Work planned for May includes:

- Demobilising activities at the eastern and western construction sites including dismantling, and removing the remaining workforce facilities
- Installing final hoarding and banners around the eastern and western construction sites
- Footpath restoration work on Waterview Street and Second Avenue
- Increased deliveries of equipment to and from the western and eastern construction sites using both sides of Great North Road, Waterview Street and Second Avenue
- Temporarily removing the public parking spaces from the front of the western construction site and Second Avenue to assist with site demobilisation works, when required
- Removing the temporary line marking and street signage from Waterview Street, Second Avenue, Great North Road and Garfield Street
- Ongoing tunnel decommissioning and completion work
- CCTV inspection of sewer manholes Waterview Street and Second Avenue
- Delivering and removing materials and equipment (out-of-hours deliveries will be notified separately).

Work hours:

Unless otherwise stated, this work will be carried out during standard construction hours:

- **Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm and Saturday 8am – 6pm.**

Some work must be undertaken outside standard construction hours to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, and workers.

Out-of-hours work planned for May includes:

- Removing the remaining workforce facilities from the western site from **6pm to 5am on Tuesday 29 April, Wednesday 30 April, Monday 5 May and Tuesday 6 May 2025.**
Street signage modifications and temporary line marking removal on Great North Road from **6pm to 5am on Thursday 8 May 2025.**
- Crane lifts of oversize equipment out of the western construction site from 6pm to 5am on **Monday 12 May and Tuesday 13 May 2025.**
- Contingency dates for all work will be notified in the weekly email construction update, if required.

Activities associated with tunnelling, such as concrete pours, removal of temporary tunnelling infrastructure and defect repairs inside the tunnel, are approved **for 24-hour operation, seven days a week.**

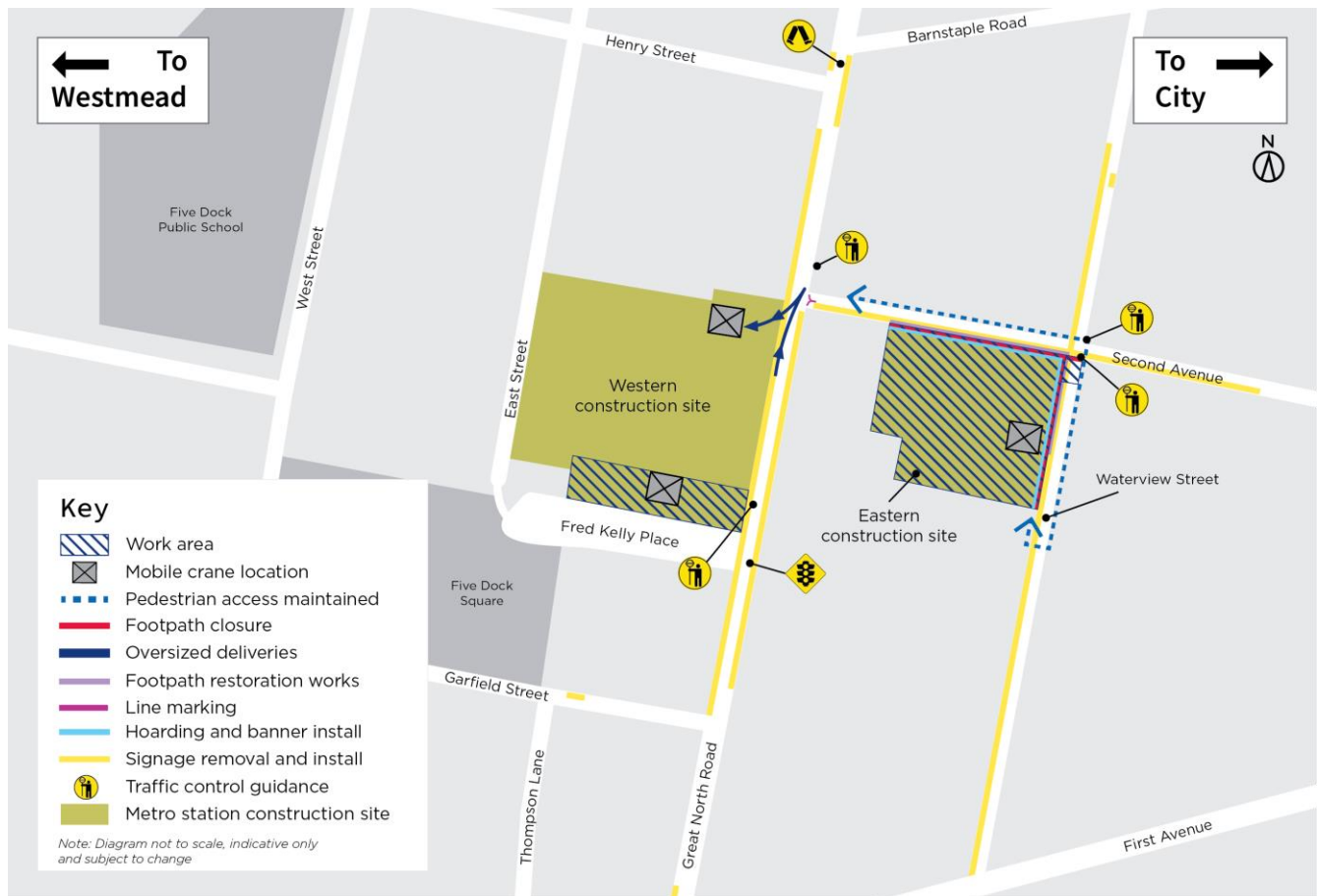
Equipment used

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: trucks, light vehicles, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, bobcat, jackhammers, elevated work platforms, excavators, street sweepers, vacuum trucks, asphaltting machines, mobile cranes, lighting towers, generators and power tools.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian, and cyclist routes

During the work, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow lanes, stop-slow traffic controls to assist with truck movements, oversized deliveries and temporary lane or footpath closures.
