# **Notification – St Marys Station footbridge**

June 2025

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project.

### Work activities in June

- lifting in new footbridge concrete beams across the train tracks and constructing new stairways
- excavating and installing utility services, such as water and sewer on Harris Street and near the multi-storey car park (up to 10 parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable during this work)
- delivering and removing materials and equipment via Hobart Street, Harris Street, Glossop Street, and Forrester Road
- continuing electrical, hydraulic, excavation and concrete work on all station platforms and within the Harris Street work area
- oversized deliveries to and from the Harris Street work area. For these deliveries, up to 10 parking spaces will be unavailable before, during, and after the weekends of 31 May - 1 June and 21 - 23 June.

## What to expect

- workers and vehicles in and around work sites, laydown areas, and station platforms
- traffic control and signs as needed
- construction equipment in use including excavators, saw cutters, trucks, cranes, concrete pumps, power tools, and survey equipment.

## When and where we'll be working

Standard working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

In **June**, work to install more concrete beams and stairs will take place continuously during planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekends.

Weekend work is planned from:

- 1am Saturday 31 May to 4am Monday 2 June
- 1am Saturday 21 June to 4am Monday 23 June.

Subject to approvals, we will be working extended hours from:

- 7am to 3pm on Saturday 7 June,
  Saturday 14 June and Saturday 28 June
- 6pm to 7am between Tuesday 10 June and Friday 20 June.

Material deliveries will also occur from **6pm** to **12am** on weeknights from **Monday 26 May** to **Monday 2 June**.

# Managing our impacts

We aim to minimise impacts on the community and environment by:

- installing safety and security fencing around our work areas
- reducing noise by turning off machinery when not in use and using noise barriers where we can.

Planned activities (subject to approval) include excavation, concrete, electrical and hydraulic work on the following dates:


- Saturday 5 July to Monday 7 July
