6 June	ETP. Cross passage hammering at XP9 continued into the evening period and led to 2 noise complaints from residents of 120 Saunders Street, Pyrmont. The extension of this work into the evening period had been notified via letterbox drop earlier that day but JCG acknowledge that this could have been better communicated to affected residents. The AA is reviewing the noise monitoring data to determine whether levels were likely to be within the groundborne noise management level (GBNML) applicable during the evening period. If levels were above the GBNML then at least 7 days' notification would have been required under Sydney Metro's Overarching Community Communications Strategy (OCCS).
26 June	CTP: NCR044. Non-compliance with CoA D51, as modified by Mod 6 in November 2024: "The outcomes of the community consultation, the identified respite periods and the scheduling of the likely out-of-hour work must be provided to the ER and AA before the out of hours work commences". Action for closure: Sydney Metro advises that no further OOHW programmed for CTP noting Substantial Completion on all surface worksites has now been achieved. In the event of any planned OOHW then CoA D51 requirements will be completed.

- Pyrmont: Cavern excavation continuing 24/7, spoil haulage and deliveries underway 24/7 (under an EPL variation), cross passage excavation underway.
- Hunter Street: shaft excavation and piling works by day, ongoing OOH tunnelling support works at Hunter Street East. Potential cumulative impact from Milligans development adjacent to Hunter Street West; demolition work at that site likely to start in August.

Tree removal and other works along Clyde Dive ATC boundary adjacent to stables; acoustic shed demolition.

All CTP sites are now demobilised and handed over noting that the final surface site handover was achieved at Five Dock
