

# Notification – Clyde/Rosehill

23 July 2025

## Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Sydney Metro has engaged Quickway Construction Pty Ltd to install high voltage (HV) conduits to the Rosehill Services Facility site, as part of ongoing construction works for Sydney Metro West. Site investigations are expected to start from mid to late September to locate existing services and assess ground conditions. Trenching works in Unwin Street and Colquhoun Street will begin once investigation works are complete.

To support this work, a temporary ancillary facility is proposed be established in Rosehill.

## Temporary ancillary facility establishment: September 2025

Work to set up the temporary ancillary facility is expected to start in September 2025 pending approvals.

The ancillary facility will be located on Durham Street, Rosehill (see map on page 2) and will be used to store plant, equipment, materials and site sheds for the forthcoming HV work at Rosehill. The ancillary facility will include site amenities, plant, conduits, cable cover, storage containers, excavated and backfill materials. Light and heavy vehicles will park at the compound during and between work shifts.

Site establishment activities will take about two weeks to complete during standard construction hours:

- **Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 6pm**

Site establishment will involve:

- Setting up a small demountable office, on-site parking, material and stockpile areas
- Installing environmental controls
- Installing shade cloth and signage on the existing fence.
- Install site security measures

The ancillary facility will be used for approximately 12 months while the HV works are being undertaken.

## Out-of-hours work

Once the ancillary facility is operational, workers will access the site during and outside of standard construction hours, including at night to support out-of-hours HV work at Rosehill.

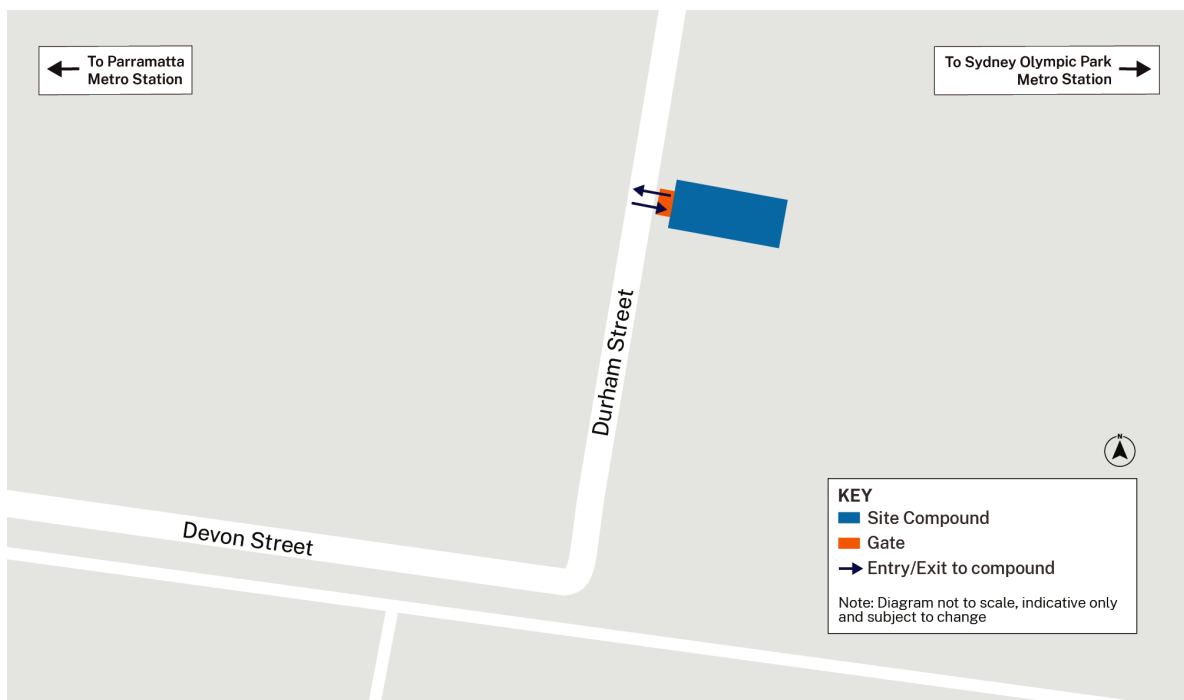
To minimise interruption on local traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers, there will be site investigations and HV work undertaken outside standard construction hours between 6pm – 5am, Monday to Friday. The community will be notified prior to these works being undertaken.

### What to expect:

- There will be some noise from machinery and equipment which will be minimised where possible
- Measures will be in place to minimise dust, including covering and wetting exposed areas
- Shade cloth will be installed around the site to minimise visual impacts
- There may be minor delays for motorists when light and heavy vehicles access the ancillary facility via a gate on Durham Street
- Lighting will be directed away from neighbouring properties at night.

**Equipment used:** includes (but is not limited to) light vehicles, heavy vehicles, hand tools, mobile crane, excavator, chainsaw, concrete saw, grinder, mulcher, forklift, roller, generator, water cart.
