No truck movements at Pyrmont West, steel roller door closed (in addition to fast-close door). No issues raised. <b>Hunter Street</b> (appox 22:40 to 23:20). Ventilation noise audible from the decline at Hunter Street East but not deemed intrusive. JCG subsequently confirmed that ventilation fans are fitted with attenuators and operate on reduced fan speed at night. Witnessed an EWP operating with tonal alarm at Hunter Street West.

## Ongoing and upcoming noise and vibration risks

### ETP:

- Pyrmont: Cavern excavation continuing 24/7, spoil haulage and deliveries underway 24/7 (under an EPL variation), cross passage excavation underway.
- Hunter Street: shaft excavation and piling works by day, ongoing OOH tunnelling support works at Hunter Street East.
   Potential cumulative impact from Milligans development adjacent to Hunter Street West; demolition work at that site likely to start in August.

#### CTP:

All CTP sites are now demobilised and handed over noting that the final surface site handover was achieved at Five Dock on 12 May 2025.

#### WTP:

• Tree removal and other works along Clyde Dive ATC boundary adjacent to stables; acoustic shed demolition.
