Notification – St Marys Station footbridge

August 2025

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project.

Work activities in August

- excavating and installing utility services, such as water and sewer on Harris Street and near the multistorey car park (up to 10 parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable during this work)
- delivering and removing materials and equipment via Hobart Street, Harris Street, Glossop Street, and Forrester Road
- continuing electrical, hydraulic, excavation and concrete work on all station platforms and within the Harris Street work area.

What to expect

- workers and vehicles in and around work sites, laydown areas, and station platforms
- traffic control and signs as needed
- construction equipment in use including excavators, saw cutters, trucks, cranes, concrete pumps, power tools, and survey equipment.

When and where we'll be working

Standard working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

Subject to approvals, we will be working extended hours for concrete pours from:

- 7am to 3pm on Saturday 2 August, Saturday 9
 August, Saturday 16 August, Saturday 23 August
 and Saturday 30 August.
- 6pm to 7am between Monday 25 August to
 Saturday 30 August (work will not be continuous).

Subject to approval, building materials will be delivered to the Harris Street site approximately three to four times per week between **6pm** and **6am** on **weeknights** from **Thursday 21 August** to **Friday 29 August**.

Please refer to the map showing our work and laydown areas, and parking impacts.

Managing our impacts

We aim to minimise impacts on the community and environment by:

- installing safety and security fencing around our work areas
- reducing noise by turning off machinery when not in use and using noise barriers where we can.

Planned work outside of standard hours over the next three months

Planned activities (subject to approval) include excavation, structural steel, concrete, electrical, drainage and hydraulic work on the following dates:


- Saturday 6 September to Monday 8 September
