

Notification – Temporary road closure

22 September 2025

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Temporary night-time road closures on Macquarie Lane and Macquarie Street, Parramatta

To support sewer upgrades, installation of a temporary road diversion and archaeological investigations within Macquarie Lane, **sections of Macquarie Street and Macquarie Lane, will be closed to traffic at night:**

- 6pm Monday 29 September to 5am Tuesday 30 September 2025,
- 6pm Tuesday 30 September to 5am Wednesday 1 October 2025,
- 6pm Wednesday 8 October to 5am Thursday 9 October 2025,
- 6pm Thursday 9 October to 5am Friday 10 October 2025,
- 6pm Friday 10 October to 5am Saturday 11 October 2025,
- 6pm Monday 13 October to 5am Tuesday 14 October 2025,
- 6pm Tuesday 14 October to 5am Wednesday 15 October 2025,
- 6pm Wednesday 15 October to 5am Thursday 16 October 2025.

The road closures will occur between the intersection of Macquarie Street and Marsden Street, and the intersection of Macquarie Lane and Smith Street, see map overleaf for details.

Works will involve:

- Setting up traffic management, VMS signage and detours around the area
- Installing road safety barriers along Macquarie Lane
- Installing road base, laying asphalt, line marking and restoring the area once work is complete
- Upgrading and re-lining sewers.

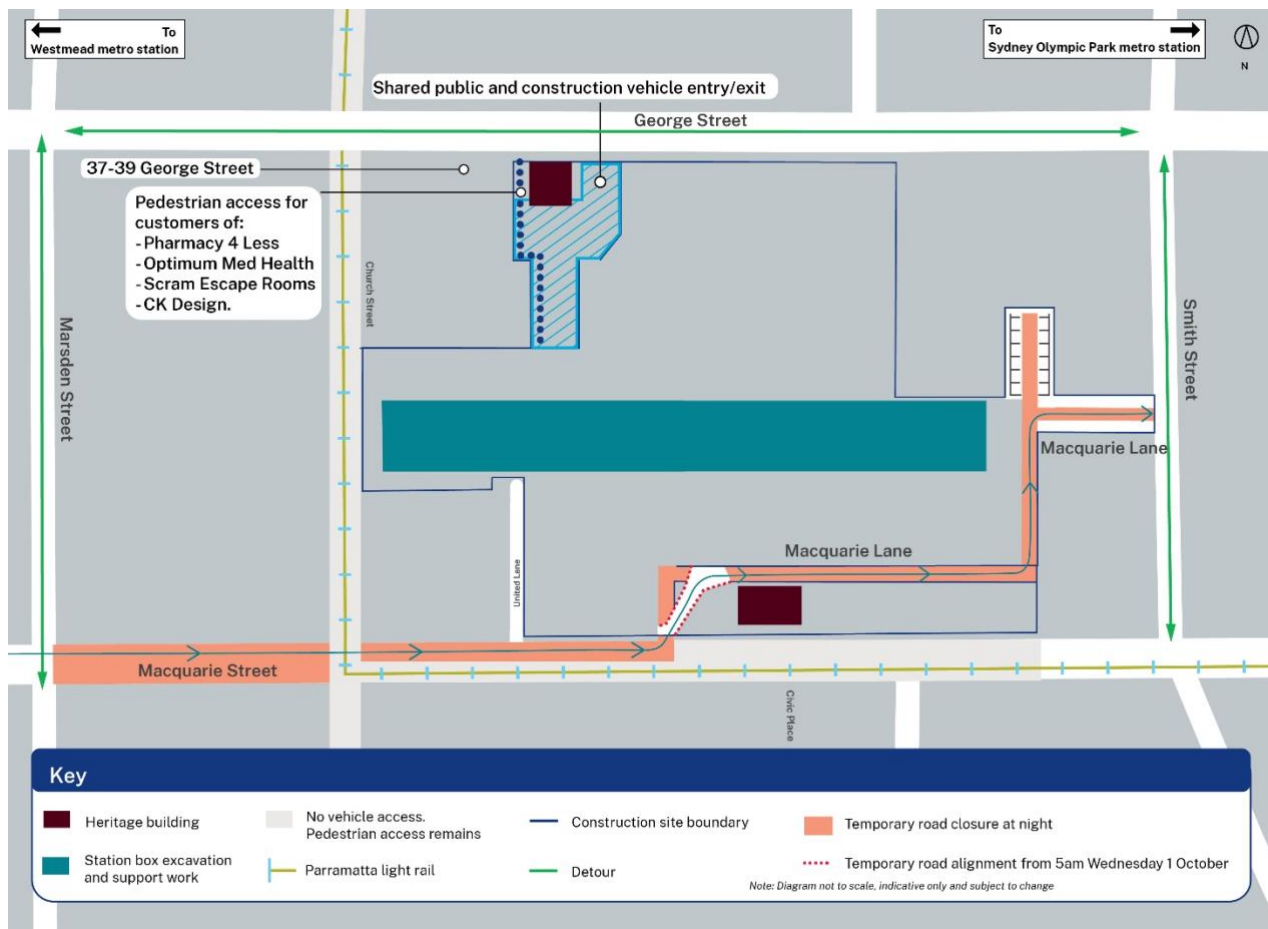

What to expect:

- Some activities will generate noise and vibration, but this will be minimised as much as possible.
- Access to businesses will be maintained unless arrangements are made with you in advance.
- Access for waste collection trucks will be maintained via traffic control.
- Traffic control and signage will be in place in surrounding streets to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with changes to traffic conditions on Macquarie Street and Macquarie Lane during planned closures at night. Please keep to the speed limits, follow detours and allow some extra time for your journey when travelling near these areas.

Equipment used: Equipment for this work will include but is not limited to hand tools tele handler, trench roller, generators, light vehicles, tipper trucks, delivery vehicles, fencing and traffic control devices.
