Notification - St Marys Station footbridge

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project

Work activities in October

- installing escalators, steel structures, roofing for the new footbridge and canopies on the station platforms
- installing drainage, electrical and other utility services
- excavating and installing utility services, such as water and sewer on Harris Street and near the multi-storey car park
- delivering and removing materials and equipment via Hobart Street, Harris Street, Glossop Street, and Forrester Road
- delivering and installing precast building panels.

What to expect

- two accessible parking spaces in the commuter car park will be temporarily unavailable to construct a new kerb ramp and other related work
- up to 30 parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable on Harris Street for utility and weekend work
- construction equipment in use including excavators, saw cutters, trucks, cranes, concrete pumps, light towers, power tools, and survey equipment.

When and where we'll be working

Standard working hours are **7am** to **6pm**, **Monday** to **Friday**, and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

In **October**, work on the new footbridge and station platforms will take place continuously during the following planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekends:

- 1am Saturday 11 October to 7am Monday 13 October
- 1am Saturday 25 October to 7am Monday 27 October.

Subject to approvals, we will be working extended hours from:

- 6pm to 7am between Wednesday 1 October and Friday 31 October (up to two weeknights per week)
- 7am to 3pm on Saturday 4 October and Saturday 18 October.

Building material and equipment will be delivered to our work areas between **6pm** and **6am** on **weeknights** from:

- Wednesday 8 October to Monday 13 October
- Wednesday 22 October to Monday 27 October.

Managing our impacts

We aim to minimise impacts on the community and environment by:

- installing safety and security fencing around our work areas
- reducing noise by turning off machinery when not in use
- managing vehicle and pedestrian access with traffic control and signs.

Planned work outside of standard hours over the next three months

Planned activities (subject to approval) include excavation, structural steel, concrete, electrical and hydraulic work on the following dates:


- Saturday 1 November to Monday 3 November

- Saturday 10 January to Monday 12 January.




