

Project Update - Waterloo Over Station Development

NOVEMBER 2025

The Waterloo Metro Quarter is being completed by a joint venture between John Holland and Mirvac, the new Waterloo Metro Quarter will be a true mixed-use precinct combining residential apartments, social housing, affordable housing, student accommodation, retail, commercial spaces, a vibrant ground plane, community facilities and public open space.

Upcoming work in November around Waterloo Metro Quarter

Finishing works and rectification activities for the Over Station Development will occur throughout November. An indicative work schedule is listed below. *Standard construction hours are Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 7.30am to 6pm.*

- Delivering and removing equipment, large machinery, and materials
- Temporary footpath closures and traffic lane closures to accommodate work activities
- Scaffold installation and removal for safe worker access
- Facade works and cleaning
- Landscaping works to Wellington Street, Cope Street Plaza, and Botany Road
- Paving and landscape work along Botany Road
- Installation of permanent traffic and parking control signage along Wellington St and Botany Rd
- Line marking on Wellington Street
- Post construction public domain and road condition surveys
- Defect rectification works internally and externally to the station as required.
- Installation of artwork to Cope Street Plaza

Waterloo Station

Standard construction hours are Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 6pm. Wellington, Buckland, Raglan, Cope Streets, Henderson and Botany Road.

- Utilities and defect rectification works internally and externally to the station
- Façade installation on the southern station box
- Civil rectification works at the intersection of Botany Road and Henderson Road

Upcoming out of hours work (OOHW) in November

Work taking place outside standard construction hours, Monday to Saturday from 6pm to 7am, and Sunday from 7am. Please note, noise levels and their impacts are subject to the location and distance of the property from the work site. We will not complete noisy work in the same location more than two nights in a row.

Waterloo over station development

- Transportation or removal of vehicles, equipment, or materials
- Internal fit-out and services installations/commissioning up to 24 hours a day (excluding Sunday and public holidays)
- Excavation, paving and landscape work along Botany Road
- Line marking on Wellington Street
- Defect rectification works internally and externally as required.



Waterloo Station

- Utilities investigations and defect rectification works internally and externally to the station
- Signalised intersection works at Botany Road and Wellington Street
- Civil works and defect rectification at the intersection of Botany Road, Cope Street, Wellington St, Henderson Road and Raglan Street.

What to expect

- Equipment used will include, but is not limited to, handheld and electric tools, jackhammers, welders, power drills, excavators, compaction equipment, elevated work platforms, concrete trucks, concrete mixers and pumps, sweeper, cranes, light and heavy vehicles, pavement cutters, line marking grinder, vacuum trucks, asphalt profiler and asphalt compactors.
- Due to the nature of the work, nearby residents may be able to hear noise and feel vibration from some of the work. The project team will limit these impacts wherever possible. A range of mitigation measures are in



place to meet the project's approval conditions and reduce noise, including turning off equipment when not in use and where possible, equipping machinery with non-tonal movement alarms and using acoustic sheeting.

- Temporary traffic changes will be in place for the safety of workers and the community during this work, including reduced speed limits, removal of parking and footpath and lane closures.
- To complete some utility work, power or water outages may be required. These will be carried out at the direction of the utility company and any impacted residents will be notified.
