

Notification – Westmead

14 January 2026

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Out-of-hours removal of oversize machinery via Hassall Street gate

As part of ongoing construction activities, tunnelling contractor GLC will remove oversize machinery from the Westmead metro station site during the following periods:

- **6pm Wednesday 21 January to 5am Thursday 22 January 2026**
- **6pm Thursday 22 January to 5am Friday 23 January 2026**

Vehicle movements will be scheduled **between 9pm and 10pm**, where possible.

The machinery will be transported off site on large haulage trucks via the Hassall Street gate, before travelling to the Great Western Highway using Hassall Street, Alexandria Avenue and Hawkesbury Road.

These vehicle movements will occur outside standard construction hours to minimise interruption to local traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers. This approach is in line with Road Occupancy Licence and Transport for NSW requirements for the movement of oversized vehicles.

Temporary removal of street parking on Hassall Street

Due to the size of the machinery, some street parking will need to be temporarily removed on Hassall Street during the following periods:

- **6pm Wednesday 21 January to 5am Thursday 22 January 2026**
- **6pm Thursday 22 January to 5am Friday 23 January 2026**


If vehicles are parked within the temporary parking removal zones, owners will be contacted by Police and the vehicles towed to a nearby parking spot in the area. For more information, contact the community team on 1800 612 173 or metrotunnelsGLC@transport.nsw.gov.au.

What to expect:

- Three parking spaces will be temporarily removed on Hassall Street
- Some activities will generate noise, but this will be minimised as much as possible
- Lighting will be used on site but will be directed away from residential properties
- Traffic controllers and signage will be used to direct pedestrians and traffic around work areas
- Access to property will be maintained, unless arrangements are made with you in advance
- Allow extra time when travelling in the area.

Equipment used: Includes (but is not limited to) crane, hand tools, light vehicles, heavy vehicles, generators, tow trucks, lighting towers, forklifts, and traffic control devices.
