

North Strathfield metro station – Electrical kiosk work

9 February 2026

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Sydney Metro has engaged Syscon to install a new kiosk substation and undertake associated civil works, as part of ongoing construction for Sydney Metro West. This work involves installing a new kiosk substation within the North Strathfield metro station site and includes associated high-voltage (HV) and low-voltage (LV) connections to existing Ausgrid electrical infrastructure.

Out-of-hours work

To minimise disruption to local traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers, trenching and some site work must be undertaken outside standard construction hours.

Upcoming out of hours work:

- **Friday, 13 February and Sunday, 15 February between 6pm and 5am** (contingency) – pre-outage works including excavation at trenching location at Waratah Street and securing excavations with steel plates. Work on Sunday, 15 February will occur only if works cannot be completed on Friday, 13 February.
- **Thursday, 19 February between 6pm and 5am** – Ausgrid commissioning outage including isolation of low voltage (LV) and high voltage (HV) circuits, removal of temporary supply cables, joints and associated equipment and temporary restoration of affected areas on Waratah Street, Queen Street and Pomeroy Street and within the site compound.

There will be temporary periods of high noise when excavating and cutting through parts of the footpath areas. **There will be no electrical supply loss to residents or businesses during these works.** These works are planned to be carried out at the earliest possible time during night works. Mitigation measures will be in place to reduce impacts to the community and businesses as much as possible. Highly impacted residents will be notified separately.


Changes to traffic and pedestrian routes:

To facilitate access to work areas and safely operate machinery, there will be:

- Temporary short-term parking removal on Gracemere Street and Waratah Street
- Temporary short-term footpath closures on Queen Street and Waratah Street
- Traffic controllers and signage to direct pedestrians
- Access to businesses and driveways will be maintained unless prior arrangements are made with affected stakeholders
- Parking will be reinstated and footpaths will be reopened after every working shift.

Equipment used: includes (but is not limited to) elevated work platforms, bucket truck, lighting towers, excavator, tipper truck, roller, concrete pump, grinders, water cart, sweeper truck, vac trucks, concrete saws, hand tools, trucks and light vehicles.
