

Monthly update – North Strathfield metro station

April 2026

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, transforming Sydney for generations to come. Sydney Metro West will target an opening date of 2032.

Gamuda has been awarded the contract to design and construct the five new metro stations at Westmead, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, and The Bays.

Sydney Metro has engaged John Holland to deliver the Linewide project. Delivering 60kms of track across the network, installation of rail systems and construction of Sydney Metro West's 38-hectare stabling and maintenance facility in Clyde.

What work are we doing?

Gamuda will commence maintenance works at North Strathfield metro station site from **Tuesday 31 March 2026**, before construction of the new station continues later this year.

Work includes:

- Delivery of machinery and equipment
- Setting up a temporary work site, including site offices
- Inspection and maintenance of utilities
- Surveying
- Setting up traffic management
- Maintenance and upkeep of the station site.

Activities will be undertaken by small crews using hand tools and small machinery within approved work areas.

All works will take place during standard construction hours, **Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and Saturday between 8am and 6pm, excluding public holidays**. You will be notified in advance of any planned out-of-hours or intrusive works.

Linewide project

Linewide contractor, John Holland will undertake work activities at the North Strathfield metro station site including:

- operation and maintenance activities within the construction site and tunnels
- delivery and removal of machinery, equipment and materials

Work will be conducted during standard construction hours for the site, which are **Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm and Saturdays from 8am to 6pm**. You will be notified in advance of any planned out-of-hours or intrusive works.

Tunnelling operation and maintenance activities within the tunnel will be undertaken **24 hours, seven days a week**.

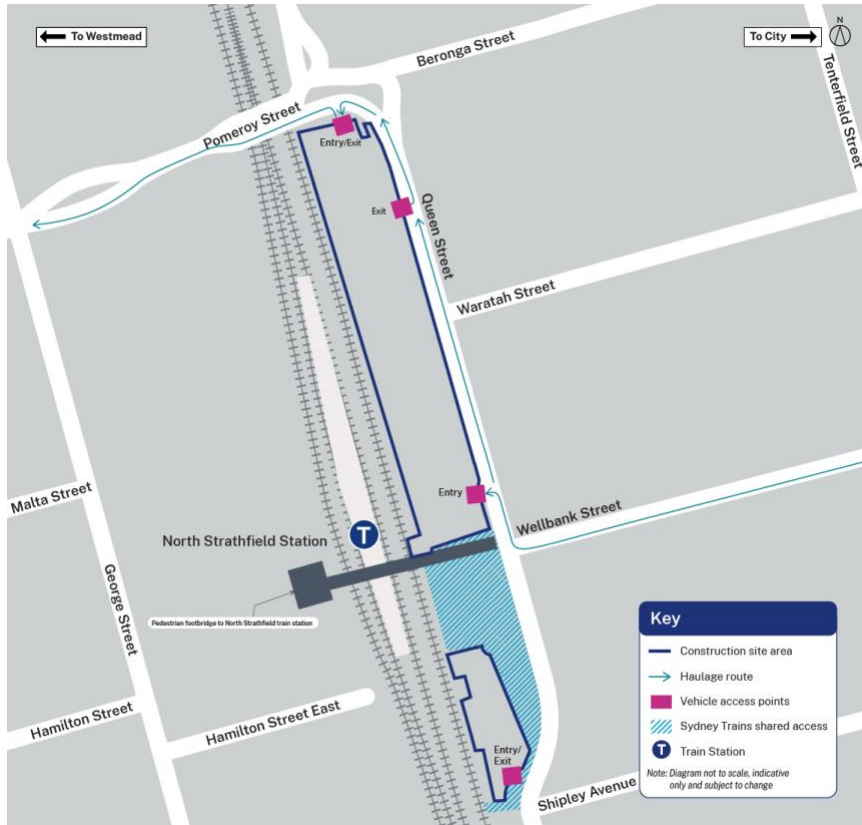
What will this mean for you?
