

Notification – Westmead

31 March 2026

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Out-of-hours work - Upcoming temporary lane and footpath closures

Tunnelling contractor GLC is in the final stages of the acoustic shed demolition on Alexandra Avenue. Out-of-hours works are planned to minimise interruption to traffic and ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers around the site. Works will be undertaken **between 8pm and 6:30am** on the following nights:

- **Tuesday 7 April to Wednesday 8 April 2026**
- **Wednesday 8 April to Thursday 9 April 2026**
- **Thursday 9 April to Friday 10 April 2026**
- **Friday 10 April to Saturday 11 April 2026**
- **Monday 13 April to Tuesday 14 April 2026**

If conditions change, works will be rescheduled to the next available night between **Tuesday 7 April and Wednesday 22 April 2026**. During the works, temporary lane and footpath closures will be in place on Alexandra Avenue between Hawkesbury Road and Hassall Street.

Works will involve:

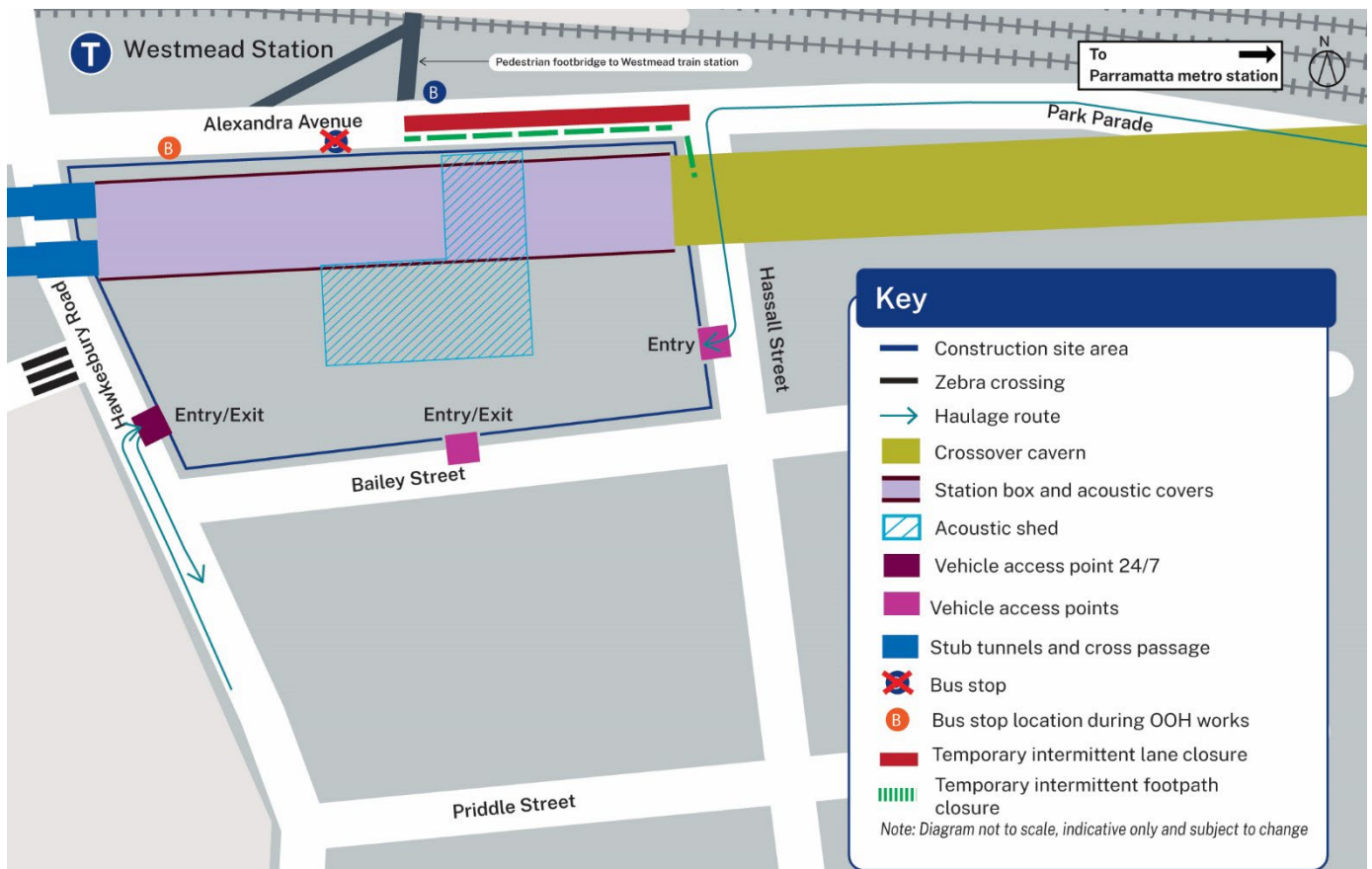
- Setting up traffic management, VMS signage and detours
- Temporary relocation of the bus stop on the southern side of Alexandra Avenue
- Temporary intermittent lane closures under a contraflow arrangement on Alexandra Avenue between Hawkesbury Road and Hassall Street
- Temporary intermittent footpath closure on Alexandra Avenue and Hassall Street
- Removal of shed panels using equipment and machinery set up on Alexandra Avenue

What to expect:

- Some activities will generate noise and vibration, but this will be minimised as much as possible.
- Access to properties will be maintained unless arrangements are made with you in advance.
- Traffic controllers and signage will direct pedestrians and traffic around work areas.
- Allow extra travel time in the area.
- Lighting will be used on site but will be directed away from residential properties.

Equipment used: Equipment for this work includes (but is not limited to) rattle guns, elevated work platforms, hammer drill, telehandler, welding equipment, excavators, rigid trucks, cranes, scissor lifts, boom lifts, semi-trailers, lighting towers and light vehicles.
