Linewide project factsheet

Linewide Overview

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, transforming Sydney for generations to come. Sydney Metro West will target an opening date of 2032.

Sydney Metro has engaged John Holland to deliver the Linewide project. This project includes delivering 60kms of track across the network, installation of rail systems and construction of Sydney Metro West’s 38-hectare stabling and maintenance facility in Clyde.

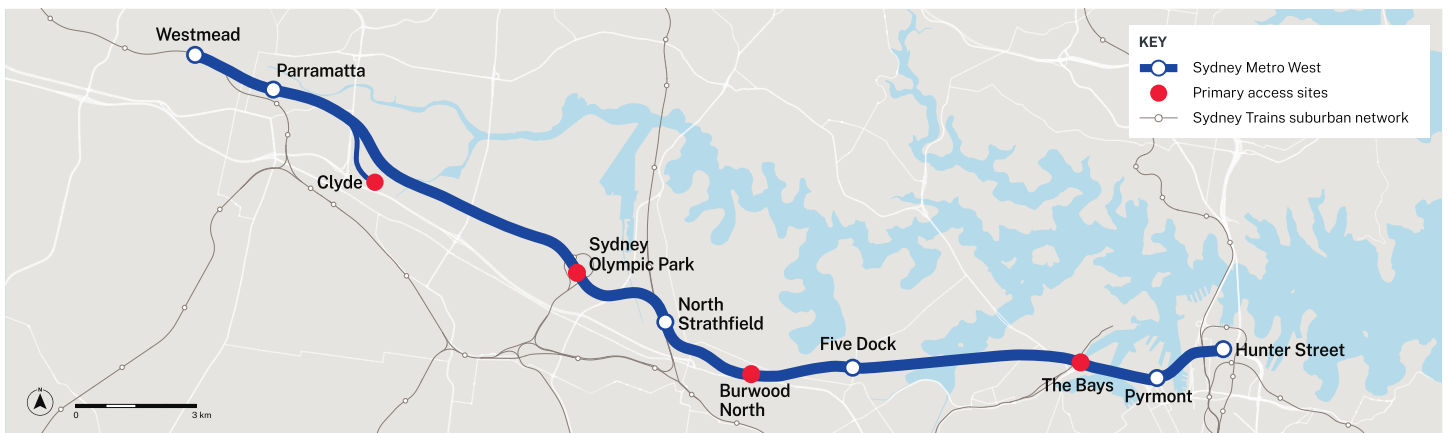
The Linewide project will deliver all end-to-end rail systems and infrastructure required for the safe, reliable and efficient operation of Sydney Metro West. This includes the complete fit-out of tunnels, cross passages, caverns and stations, as well as the delivery of key operational facilities and rail systems across the alignment.

Creating facilities to support Metro operations

The Clyde precinct’s 16 new buildings will be constructed to support efficient operations for a fleet of 16 metro trains. These facilities will support the operation, power supply, servicing, and maintenance of Metro West trains, playing a vital role in ensuring their efficient functionality. The landscaping works will further enhance the surrounding environment, creating a space that is both functional and visually appealing.

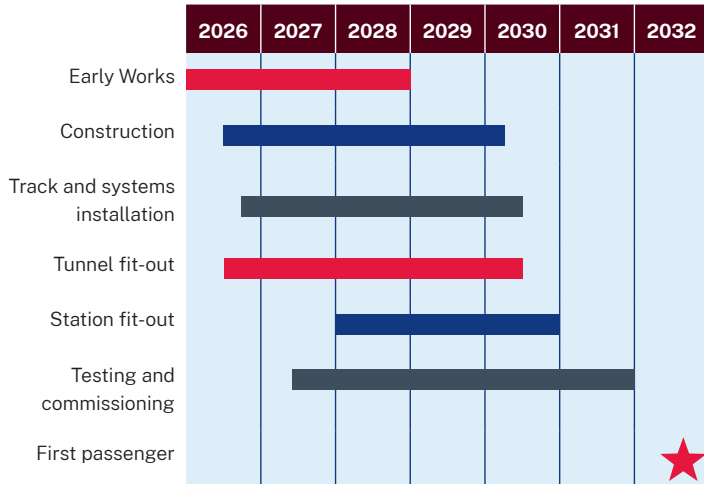
When and where we’ll be working

The project will use access points along the entire Sydney Metro West alignment at various stages, depending on construction needs. Four primary access sites will be utilised throughout construction at Clyde, Sydney Olympic Park, Burwood North and The Bays.

What's happening on the ground and underground

60km of track

laid across two tunnels and the Clyde facility, featuring four crossovers, one junction, and one turnback

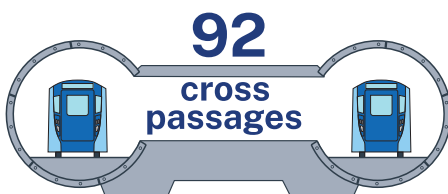
65.5km of overhead wiring

will be installed to supply power to the metro fleet



of mechanical and electrical power cabling will be installed — equivalent to the driving distance between Melbourne and Sydney

A staggering **77,000m³** of concrete will be installed across the Clyde facility and tunnels



within the tunnels will be fitted out with equipment to ensure safe operations and provide emergency access



Sustainability

The project is being delivered in alignment with the Infrastructure Sustainability Council (ISC) framework and the Green Building Council of Australia's Green Star rating system, reinforcing our commitment to sustainable, environmentally responsible infrastructure.

We're taking proactively steps to reduce environmental impacts during construction, including:



Over 1,200 trees will be planted across the Clyde precinct



100% beneficial reuse of reuseable soil



Achieve a minimum 20% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions



Achieve an ISC 2.2 Gold rating for the project



The project targets a minimum 65 point Green Star rating, equivalent to a 5 Star 'Australian Excellence' sustainability standard



20% of all construction vehicles and equipment operate without fossil fuels.

Working with the community and local businesses

The Linewide stakeholder and community engagement team will work closely with the station contractor teams to keep communities informed throughout construction. Together, we will:

- provide clear and timely updates
- coordinate notifications across the alignment
- listen to community feedback and respond to concerns
- support local residents, businesses and stakeholders during construction
- encourage our workforce to support local businesses.
