

Monthly update – Five Dock Station

Stations Package West

June 2026

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, transforming Sydney for generations to come. Sydney Metro West will target an opening date of 2032.

Gamuda has been awarded the contract to design and construct the five new metro stations at Westmead, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, and The Bays.

Sydney Metro has engaged John Holland to deliver the Linewide project. Delivering 60kms of track across the network, installation of rail systems and construction of Sydney Metro West's 38-hectare stabling and maintenance facility in Clyde.

What work are we doing?

Gamuda will continue maintenance and investigation works at Five Dock Station site during June 2026 before construction of the new station continues later this year.

Work includes:

- Delivery of machinery and equipment
- Setting up a temporary work site, including site offices, security, access controls and gate adjustments
- Site investigations of sub-surface conditions
- Utility surveys, geotechnical investigations and utility connections within site

- Installing environmental controls and monitoring equipment to mitigate construction impacts
- Survey works
- Setting up traffic management and signage installation

- Maintenance and upkeep of the station site
- Setting up a site office at 21 Waterview Street.

Linewide work activities at the Five Dock Station site will include:

- Operation and maintenance activities within the construction site and tunnel
- Delivery and removal of machinery, equipment and materials.

All works will take place during standard construction hours, **Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and Saturday between 8am and 6pm, excluding public holidays**. You will be notified in advance of any planned out-of-hours or intrusive works.

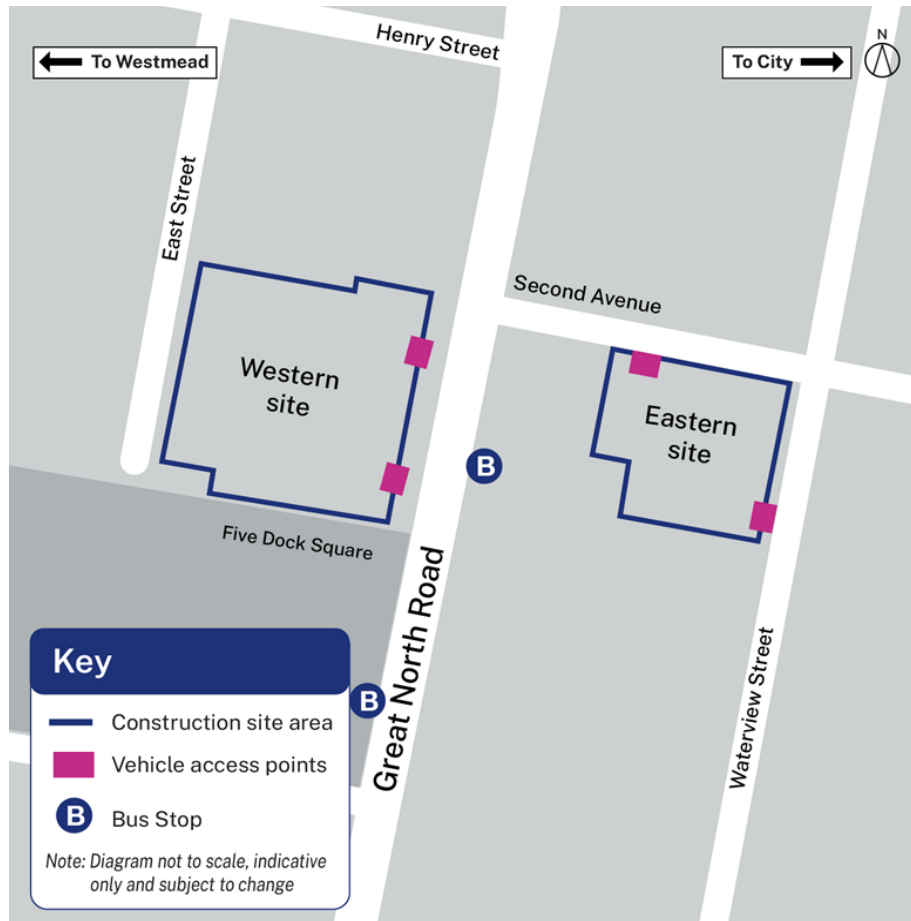
Tunnelling operation and maintenance activities within the tunnel will be undertaken **24 hours, seven days a week**.
