

Notification – St Marys Station footbridge

July 2026

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro–Western Sydney Airport project

Work activities in July

- installing steel, cladding, glass panels and roofing for the new footbridge
- building and fitting out new lifts and escalators
- footpath, landscaping and pavement work on Harris Street and near the multi-storey car park
- installing hydraulic, electrical, mechanical, fire and other utility services
- delivering and removing materials and equipment via Hobart Street, Harris Street, Glossop Street, and Forrester Road.

Planned night and weekend work

In **July**, work on the new footbridge and station platforms will take place continuously during the planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekends from:

- **10pm Friday 17 July to 7am Monday 20 July**
- **10pm Friday 24 July to 7am Monday 27 July.**

Subject to approvals, we will be working extended hours during the following periods:

- from **7am to 3pm** on **Saturday 4** and **Saturday 11 July**
- from **6pm to 6am** between **Monday 20 July** and **Friday Monday 24 July** and between **Monday 27 July** and **Friday 31 July** to install platform tactile markers, work on the new lift in the northern plaza, and asphalt and kerb work in the northern plaza.

Building material and equipment may be delivered to our work areas between **6pm** and **6am** on **weeknights**.

Our standard working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

What to expect

- two accessible parking spaces in the multi-storey

- commuter car park remain unavailable to provide safe space for work activities in the new plaza area
- up to 16 parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable on Harris Street for weekend work, night work and deliveries
- temporary footpath closure on Harris Street, with pedestrian detours in place
- temporary delays accessing the multi-storey commuter car park at night as we carry out asphalt and kerb work
- construction equipment in use will include excavators, saw cutters, trucks, cranes, concrete pumps and lighting towers.

Managing our impacts

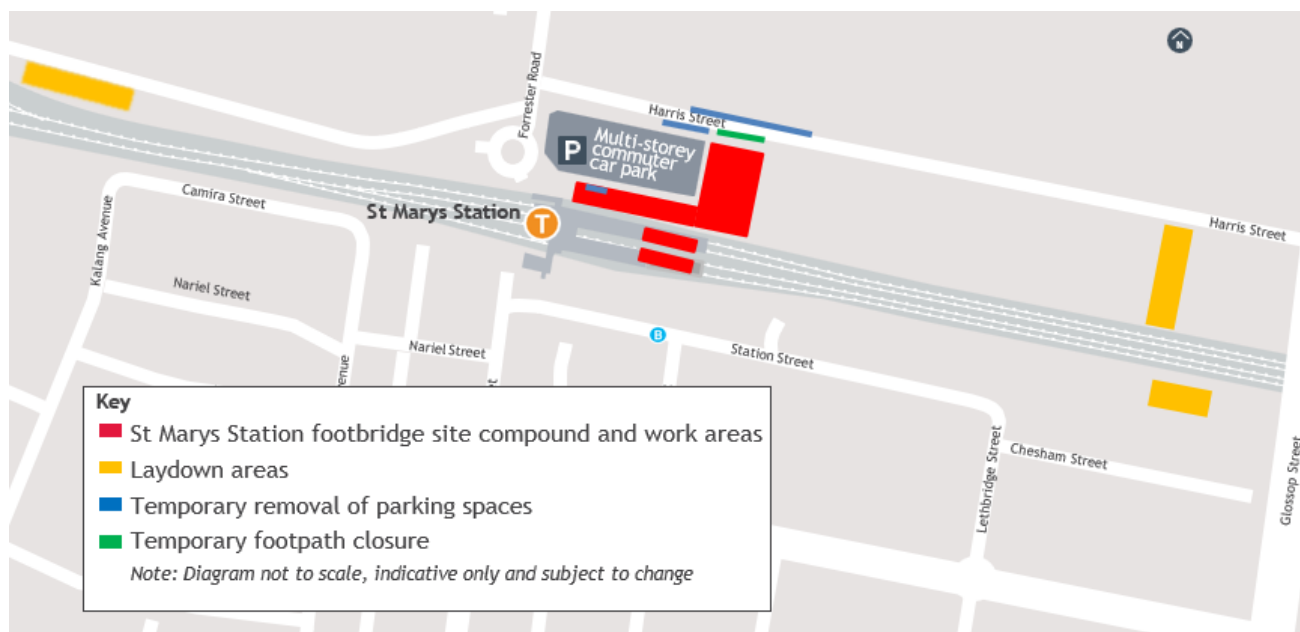
We aim to minimise impacts on the community and environment by:

- installing safety and security fencing around our work areas
- reducing noise by turning off machinery when not in use
- managing vehicle and pedestrian access with traffic control and signs.

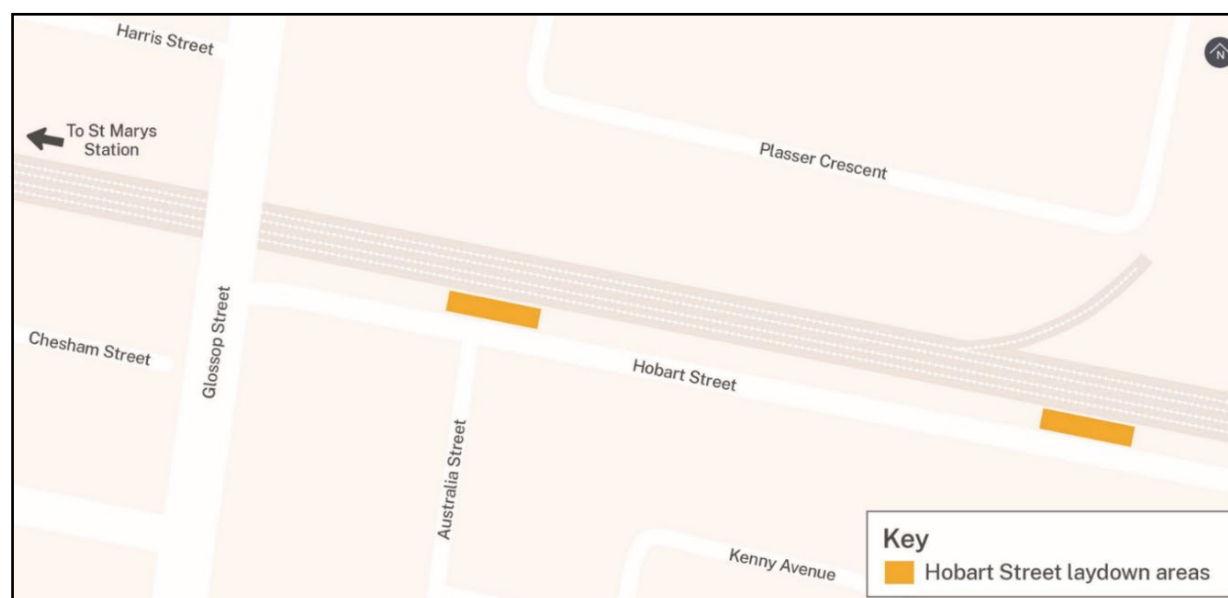
Planned work outside of standard hours over the next three months
