

Notification – Out of hours survey equipment removal - Hunter Street (Sydney CBD)

23 July 2026

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, transforming Sydney for generations to come.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD

Tunnelling for Sydney Metro West is complete, with Westmead now connected to the Sydney CBD, through the twin metro tunnels.

Out of hours work

John Holland, CPB Contractors, Ghella (JCG) will be undertaking the removal of prism monitoring devices from buildings around both Hunter Street construction sites located within the CBD.

To minimise impacts on traffic and ensure the safety of pedestrians, this work will be carried out between **6pm to 5am, Monday to Sunday** from **late July until late September 2026**. See map overleaf for work locations.

If your building requires the removal of a prism monitoring device, we will contact you directly with the expected date it will be removed.

What will this mean for you?

- Presence of temporary lighting at each work area
- Intermittent noise from hand tools and equipment
- Increase of construction vehicle movements
- Temporary loss of street parking in some locations.

Traffic and Pedestrian changes

Intermittent partial footpath and lane closures will be in place during this work, please follow the direction of traffic control. Access to property driveways located within the work zones will be maintained at all times.

Equipment used

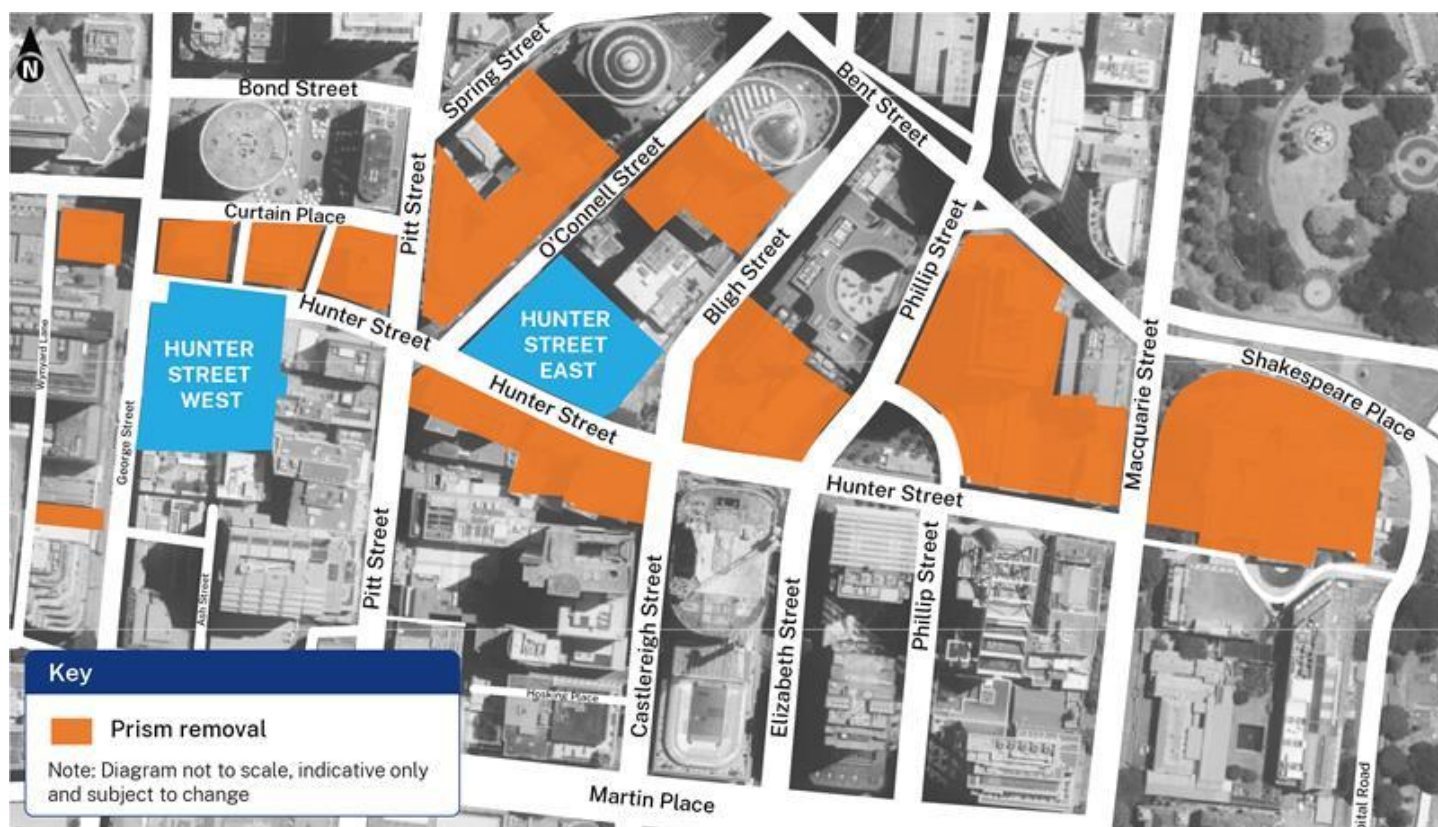
Equipment used for works includes but is not limited to elevated work platforms, hand tools, heavy vehicles, traffic management and signage.
