

Notification – St Marys Station footbridge

August 2026

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro–Western Sydney Airport project

Work activities in August

- installing steel, cladding, glass panels and roofing for the new footbridge
- building and fitting out new lifts and escalators
- footpath, landscaping and pavement work on Harris Street and near the multi-storey car park
- installing hydraulic, electrical, mechanical, fire and other utility services
- delivering and removing materials and equipment via Hobart Street, Harris Street, Glossop Street, and Forrester Road.

Planned night and weekend work

In August, work on the new footbridge and station platforms will take place continuously during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend from **10pm Friday 14 August to 7am Monday 17 August**.

Subject to approvals, we will be working extended hours during the following periods:

- Saturdays from **7am to 3pm** on **1, 8, 22 and 29 August**
- weeknights from **6pm to 6am** between **Monday 3 August and Friday 7 August** and between **Monday 24 August and Friday 28 August** to install platform tactile markers, and to remove the temporary fencing on the platforms.

Building material and equipment may be delivered to our work areas between **6pm and 6am** on **weeknights**.

Our standard working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

What to expect

- two accessible parking spaces in the multi-storey commuter car park remain unavailable to provide safe space for work activities in the new plaza area
- up to 16 parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable on Harris Street for weekend work, night work and deliveries
- temporary footpath closure on Harris Street, with pedestrian detours in place
- temporary delays accessing the multi-storey commuter car park at night as we carry out asphalt and kerb work
- construction equipment in use will include excavators, saw cutters, trucks, cranes, concrete pumps and lighting towers.

Managing our impacts

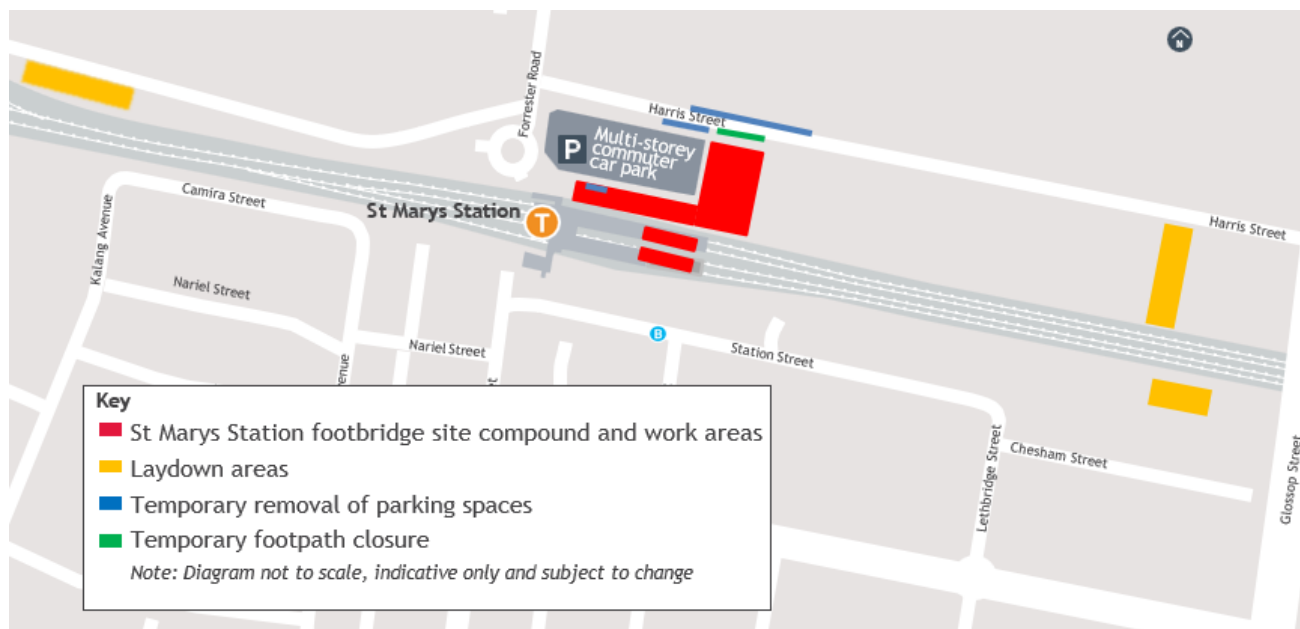
We aim to minimise impacts on the community and environment by:

- managing vehicle and pedestrian access with traffic control and signs.

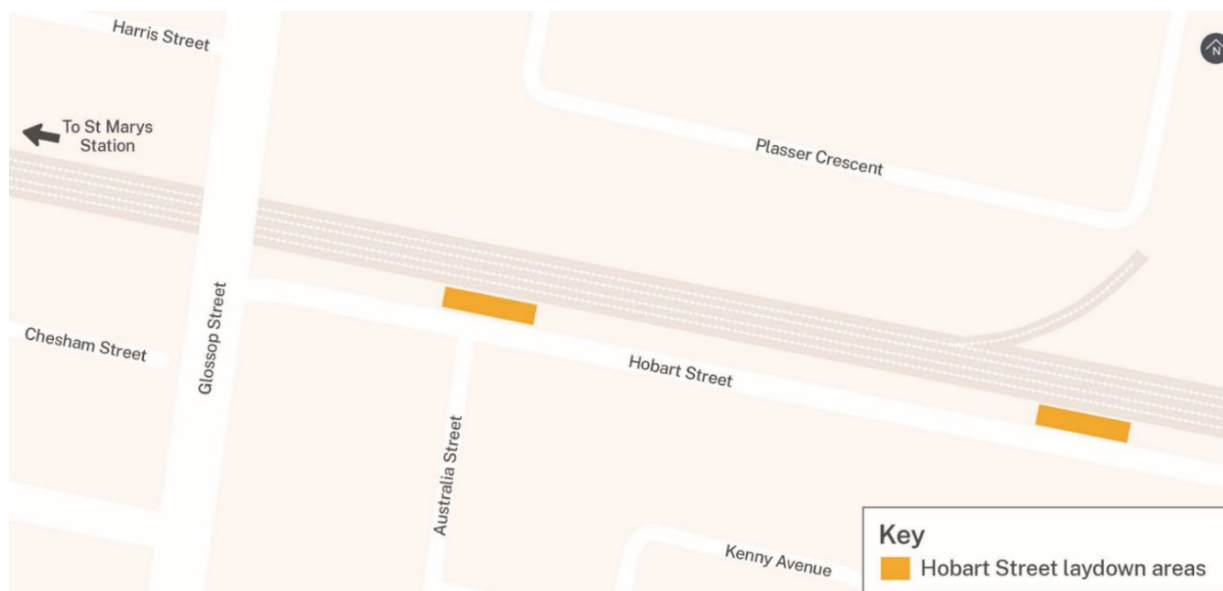
Planned work outside of standard hours over the next three months
