

Notification – out-of-hours work – Sydney Olympic Park

20 August 2026

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, transforming Sydney for generations to come. Sydney Metro West will target an opening date of 2032.

Sydney Metro has engaged John Holland to deliver the Linewide package. Delivering 60kms of track across the network, installation of rail systems and construction of Sydney Metro West's 38-hectare stabling and maintenance facility in Clyde.

What work are we doing?

Linewide will be undertaking out-of-hours construction activities from Wednesday 26 August until November 2026, weather dependant.

Work will include, rail preparation activities including welding and grinding of rail, as well as rail movements within the station box and tunnels.

Out-of-hours construction activities will be undertaken **24 hours per day, seven days a week.**

What will this mean for you?

These activities are expected to have a low noise impact.

- Construction workers and vehicles on site
- Noise from machinery and equipment

- Truck and construction vehicle movements via Herb Elliott Avenue, Figtree Drive, Olympic Boulevard and Australia Avenue
- Presence of lighting within site.

Managing our impacts on the community

We aim to manage our out-of-hours work to minimise disruption to the community and the environment. This includes:

- Plan noisy activities that are close to residents during standard construction hours or early evening, where possible
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Direct lighting towards work areas and away from neighbouring properties
- Positioning plant and equipment away of sensitive receivers where possible.

Equipment and machinery used

Includes (but is not limited to) excavators, delivery trucks, survey equipment, telehandlers, light towers, welders, grinders, elevated work platforms, forklifts, light vehicles, mobile cranes, generators, power and hand tools and drills, and tunnel transport such as buggies, trolleys and other materials.
