

Notification –Westmead

10 August 2026

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Gamuda has been awarded the Stations Package West contract to design and construct the five new metro stations at Westmead, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, and The Bays.

Sydney Metro has engaged John Holland to deliver the Linewide package, installing 60kms of track and rail systems across the network and construction of the 38-hectare stabling and maintenance facility in Clyde.

Out-of-hours work - Sewer line works

Last month, tunnelling contractor GLC inspected sewer lines on Alexandra Avenue. As a result of those inspections, some sections of the sewer line require repair work. To complete these repairs, GLC will be working **from 6pm Monday 17 August to 5am Tuesday 18 August 2026**, weather and site conditions permitting.

During this work, the bus stop on the southern side of Alexandra Avenue will be temporarily relocated closer to Hawkesbury Road from **8pm Monday 17 August to 5am Tuesday 18 August 2026** (see map overleaf).

If the repairs cannot be completed within one night, they will continue from **6pm Tuesday 18 August to 5am Wednesday 19 August 2026**.

To minimise disruption to local traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers, this work must be undertaken outside standard construction hours.

Work activities are subject to ground and weather conditions and may be rescheduled if required. We will notify you via our email updates if this needs to happen.

What work we are doing?

- Setting up traffic control on Alexandra Avenue
- CCTV investigations and repairs within the sewer line at two locations on Alexandra Avenue (see map)

What to expect:

- Traffic management and detours will be set up in surrounding streets to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with changes to traffic conditions. Please observe speed limits, follow detours and allow some extra travel time near these areas.
- Footpaths will remain open to pedestrians.
- Access to properties will be maintained unless arrangements are made with you in advance.
- Lighting will be directed to the work areas and away from residential properties.

Equipment used:

Includes (but is not limited to) hand tools, CCTV truck, jet truck, jackhammer, generator, compressor and light vehicles.
