

Notification – Burwood North Station surveying and geotechnical investigations

31 August 2026

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, transforming Sydney for generations to come. Sydney Metro West will target an opening date of 2032.

Gamuda has been awarded the Stations Package West (SPW) contract to design and construct the five new Metro stations at Westmead, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, and The Bays.

Sydney Metro has engaged John Holland to deliver the Linewide package. Delivering 60kms of track across the network, installation of rail systems and construction of Sydney Metro West's 38-hectare stabling and maintenance facility in Clyde.

Investigation work – Burwood Road and Burton Street, Concord

Gamuda will commence surveying and geotechnical investigations on Burwood Road and Burton Street, Concord (see map overleaf).

These activities will be carried out between **9:00am and 3pm** on the following days*;

- **Monday 7 September 2026**
- **Tuesday 8 September 2026**
- **Wednesday 9 September 2026**
- **Thursday 10 September 2026**
- **Friday 11 September 2026 (contingency).**

*Weather and site conditions permitting.

Work will include:

- Surveying and marking up of service locations
- Setting up of traffic management near investigation locations to maintain traffic flow
- Drilling bore holes with a drill rig and excavating to assess sub-surface conditions
- Removing excess spoil from site using a vacuum excavation truck and disposing offsite
- Reinstating the area at completion of the work.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes

To support these activities, temporary intermittent lane closures are required in sections on Burwood Road and Burton Street.

Pedestrian and vehicle access in these areas will be maintained, and traffic control and signage will be in place.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Noise from machinery and equipment, but this will be minimised as much as possible
- Access to your property will be maintained, unless arrangements are made with you in advance
- Traffic controllers and signage will be used to direct pedestrians and traffic around work areas

Managing our impacts on the community

We aim to manage our work to minimise disruption to the community and the environment and we will:

- Conduct noise and vibration monitoring as required
- Direct lighting towards work areas and away from neighbouring properties
- Apply dust suppression measures as required

Equipment and machinery used

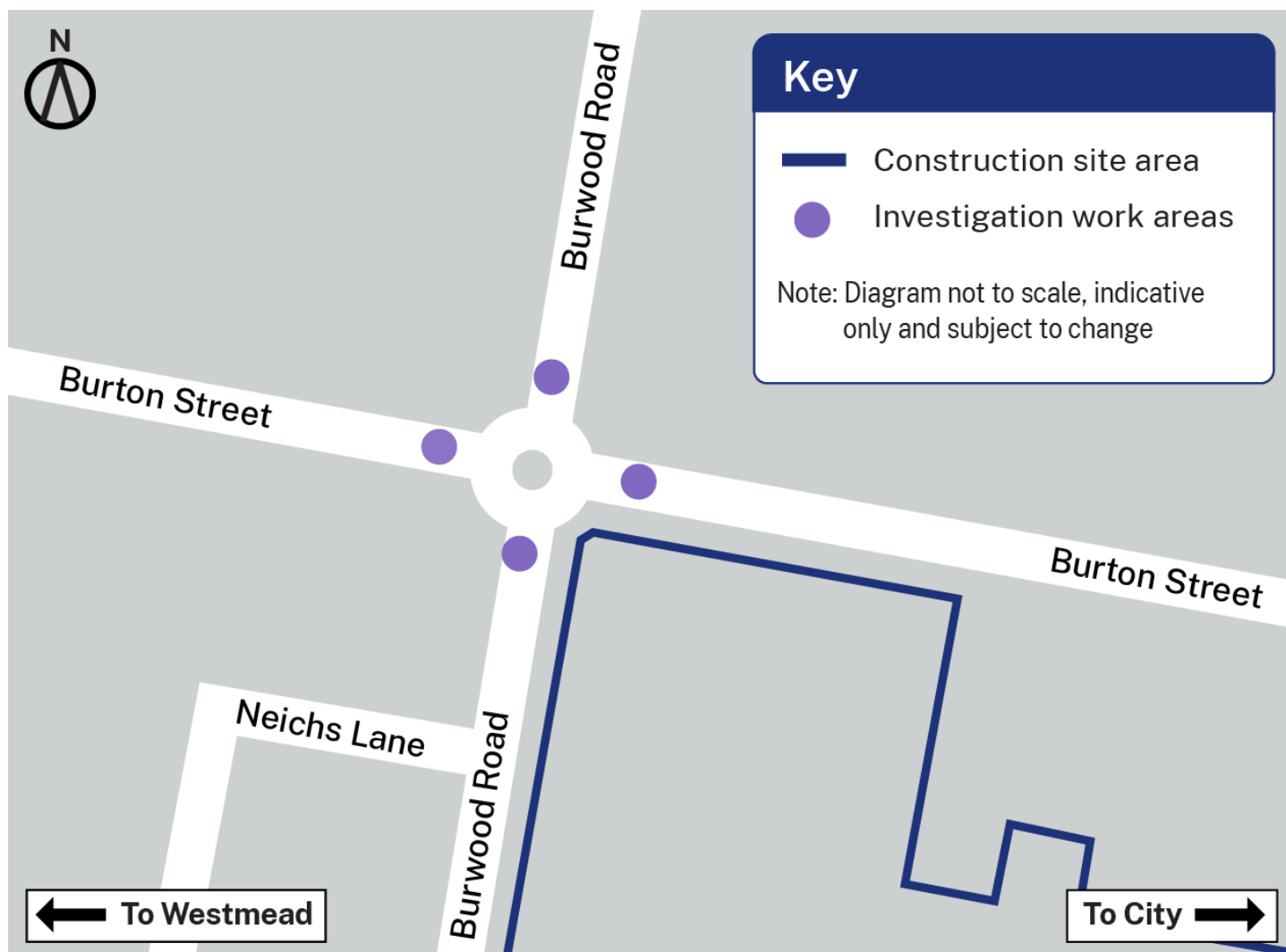
