

Notification – Westmead

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Adjusting hoarding on Bailey Street, Westmead.

Tunnelling contractor GLC will be adjusting the site hoarding along the northern side of Bailey Street between Hawkesbury Road and Hassall Street. Work will be carried out during standard construction hours between **Monday 7 September** and **Monday 5 October 2026**.

If weather or site conditions impact the timeframe, updates will be provided via signage on Bailey Street and through future Westmead community updates.

Temporary removal of parking on Bailey Street

Due to site hoarding works, parking on the northern side of Bailey Street will to be temporarily removed during the following periods:

- **From 7am Monday 7 September to 6pm Monday 5 October 2026**

If vehicles are parked within the temporary parking removal zones, owners will be contacted by Police, and the vehicles will be towed to a nearby parking spot in the area. For more information, contact the community team on 1800 612 173 or metrotunnelsGLC@transport.nsw.gov.au.

What to expect:

- The northern parking spaces will be temporarily removed on Bailey Street
- The northern footpath will be temporarily closed on Bailey Street.
- Some activities will generate noise, but this will be minimised as much as possible
- Traffic controllers and signage will be used to direct pedestrians and traffic around work areas
- Access to property will be maintained, unless arrangements are made with you in advance
- Allow extra time when travelling in the area.

Equipment used: Includes (but is not limited to) hand tools, light vehicles, excavator, drill, scaffold, telehandler, concrete agitator, generator and traffic control devices.

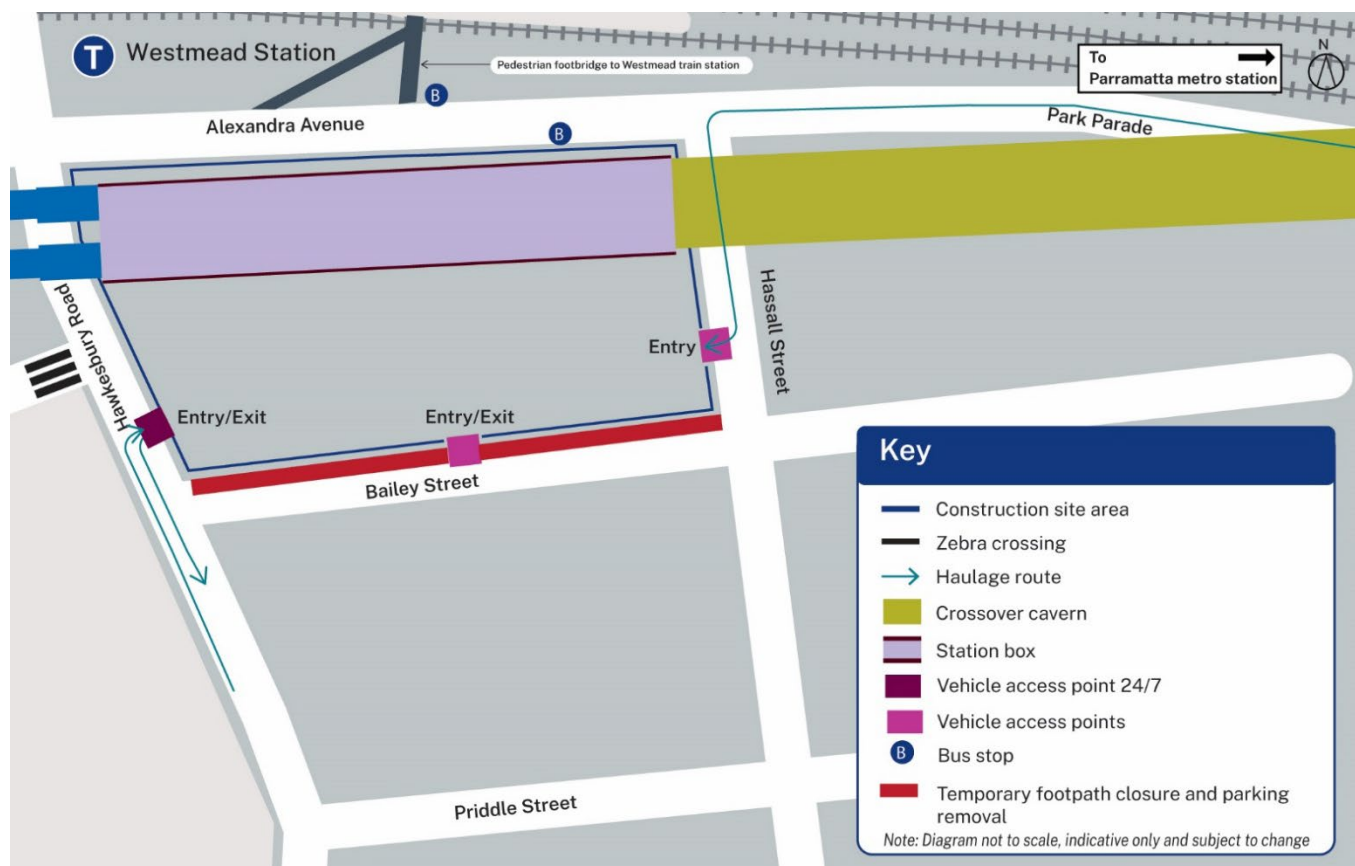
