# **Project update - Campsie substation**

#### October 2021

## Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's north west with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. There will be new CBD metro railway stations underground at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and the new metro platforms at Central Station. In 2024, Sydney will have 31 metro railway stations and a 66 km standalone metro railway system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history. There will be ultimate capacity for a metro train every two minutes in each direction under the Sydney city centre.

Systems Connect (an unincorporated joint venture between CPB Contractors and UGL Limited) is delivering line-wide work including installing metro rail track, power systems and infrastructure to turn the excavated tunnels into a working railway between Chatswood and Sydenham. Line-wide work also includes the permanent systems, services and buildings required for Sydney Metro operations between Chatswood and Bankstown.

#### Lifting the substation modular buildings into place

Systems Connect is installing a new substation on Lillian Street, Campsie. Between **10pm Thursday 14 October and 5am Monday 18 October 2021** we will be lifting the modular buildings into place. Other work will continue at Campsie train station.

Work to install the substation will involve installing a crane, lifting the buildings into place and dismantling the crane. In order to lift the substation buildings, Lillian Street, Loch Street and Beamish Street will be closed with detours in place for local traffic. Pedestrian access will be maintained with the support of traffic control. More information on traffic changes are in the map over the page. These changes are needed to support the arrival of oversized vehicles and for the installation of the substation. Oversized deliveries will arrive outside of standard construction hours.

#### Temporary parking restrictions

To allow us to lift the substation into place safely, there will be no parking on Lillian Street, Dewar Street, Carrington Street (between Lillian Street and Carrington Square), Carrington Square and Anglo Road between 10pm Thursday 14 October and up until 5am Monday 18 October 2021. Alternative parking is available, please contact the project team for more information. Clearways are strict no-parking zones and apply even to local residents or Mobility Scheme Permit holders. Check signs before parking as vehicles left in clearways could be towed.

We will need the following machinery to do the work: a large crane, a pick and carry crane, an elevated work platform, two trucks with oversized loads, support trucks for the crane, lighting towers and construction vehicles.

#### **Project work hours**

As outlined above, this work will be carried out between 10pm Thursday 14 October and up until 5am Monday 18 October 2021. Outside of these dates, work at the substation will continue during standard construction hours, Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 6pm.

#### Underline crossing work

Over the substation module lift weekend, we will also be completing an underline crossing inside the rail corridor near the substation. This will include sleeper and clip removal, excavation, local plant movements, rock hammering, installation of conduits, backfilling (including with ballast), compaction with wacker packer/trench roller, sleeper installation and clipping up and tamping. Deliveries and spoil removal for this work may need to occur outside of the weekend. Systems Connect will also carry out high voltage cable installation work off South

Parade, starting near the intersection with Beamish Street. For more information about this work please refer to the monthly notification.
