



Notification - Westmead

24 August 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

Westmead site fencing

To prepare for the start of construction, initial site establishment works will be undertaken to secure the Westmead station site.

From **Tuesday 31 August 2021** Sydney Metro will construct temporary fencing around the site perimeter as detailed on the next page.

Work will be complete during standard construction hours **Monday to Friday 7am-6pm and Saturday and Sunday 7am-6pm.**

During the works our team will attend site to ensure the safety and security of the area as we prepare for larger site establishment and demolition. As such, you may see security staff onsite undertaking safety and surveillance activities.

Should any circumstances arise where out of hours work is required, a notification will be sent to properties that are directly affected and steps will be taken to minimise the disruption to local residents and workers.

Sydney Metro will continue to undertake work across its projects in accordance with current NSW Government advice and will continue to implement social distancing and travel and hygiene measures in accordance with Public Health Orders to protect employees and members of the community.


Work will involve:

- Establishing the site with general activities such as cleaning and land preparation
- Delivering and setting up temporary site fencing around the perimeter of the Westmead metro station site
- Installation of shade cloth and signage
- Light vehicle movements

What to expect:

- The work may generate some noise but impact is expected to be minimal
- Increased vehicle movements
- Construction machinery and equipment onsite
- Traffic control and directional signage may be required for the safety of workers and the community
