



Notification - Parramatta

30 September 2021

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West - a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD.

Sydney Metro was granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and The Bays for Sydney Metro West in March 2021.

Parramatta early site establishment activities

To prepare for the start of construction, early site establishment activities will be undertaken by Sydney Metro at the future Parramatta metro station site. This work is required to set up contractor site facilities prior to the installation of hoarding and demolition activities planned to begin later this year. Survey work will also be undertaken along Macquarie Street and Smith Street to inform future Parramatta Station design.

As previously notified, the City Centre Car Park on Horwood Place will permanently close on **Thursday, 30 September 2021**. Following the closure, Sydney Metro will install temporary fencing around the car park perimeter to secure the site and ensure the safety and security of the area.

Early site establishment and surveys will begin **Thursday**, **7 October 2021** for up to five weeks, weather and site conditions permitting. This will include delivery of materials to site to allow for construction of site facilities. Work will be completed during standard construction hours **Monday to Friday 7am-6pm and Saturday and Sunday 7am-6pm**.

Sydney Metro will continue to undertake work across its projects in accordance with current NSW Government advice and will continue to implement social distancing and travel and hygiene measures in accordance with Public Health Orders to protect employees and members of the community.

Work will involve:

- Land Surveys using standard surveying hand held equipment
- Delivery of materials to site for construction of site amenities
- Small to medium truck movements to site. Vehicle movements will occur via George Street and Horwood Place
- Construction of site amenities including sheds and office blocks. These will be established within existing
 vacant properties within the project site
- Installation of temporary fencing and shade cloth where required

What to expect:

- The work may generate some noise but impact is expected to be minimal
- Increased small to medium vehicle movements
- Delivery vehicles will access Horwood Place via George Street
- Traffic control and directional signage may be required for the safety of workers and the community
- Pedestrian and vehicle access will be maintained at all times
