

Notification – Sydney International Speedway, Eastern Creek

A new world-class speedway for Western Sydney

The NSW Government is delivering a world class speedway within Western Sydney Parklands' Precinct 5: Eastern Creek Motor Sports which will be an exciting addition to the existing motorsport precinct and create a Motorplex destination for international, national and local racing events.

The new speedway will be a key contributor to the NSW economy and support tourism in Western Sydney, bringing in interstate and overseas competitors, crews and spectators.

Planning approval was granted for construction of the Sydney International Speedway in December 2020 and major works commenced January 2021.

Speedway construction:

Construction work will continue within the Sydney International Speedway site, the Sydney Dragway site, on Ferrers Road and in the area south of Ferrers Road known as Pipeline Park. See map overleaf for work locations.

This work, as well as any noisy work will be undertaken during standard construction hours of Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 6pm.

Over the coming months, some work may take place outside of standard construction hours, between 6pm and 7am Monday to Friday, 6pm Friday to 8am Saturday, and 6pm Saturday to 7am Monday.

Out of hours work may include general construction activities such as earthworks, movement of materials within the site, structural works, delivery of materials and equipment to and from the site, and attended noise monitoring. Any residents or businesses in close proximity to the work will be specifically notified of the out of hours activities.

Work activities will involve:

- Utility work within car parks and speedway area
- Excavation, earthworks and movement of spoil
- Removal of fill from the site
- Construction of retaining walls and car parks
- Safe removal and handling of asbestos where required
- Attended noise monitoring in areas outside the construction site
- Relocation of site compound.

What to expect:

- This work will generate some noise but impact is expected to be minimal
- Movement of fill will result in increased truck movements in the area.

Changes to traffic:

During these works traffic control and directional signage may be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists. This may include temporary partial road closures. The times of these changes will vary and are dependent on road authority approvals.

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: excavators, dozers, scrapers, graders, compactors, dump trucks, cranes, road trucks, water cart, street sweepers, concrete trucks and pumps, multi-tyre roller, smooth drum roller, pavers and lighting towers.
